acupuncture	A system of complementary medicine in which fine needles are inserted in the skin at specific points along what are considered to be lines of energy (meridians), used in the treatment of various physical and mental conditions.
biofeedback	A process whereby electronic monitoring of a normally automatic bodily function is used to train someone to acquire voluntary control of that function.
chiroprapist	A person who treats the feet and their ailments. <i>She decided to train as a chiroprapist.</i>
counselor	Someone who gives advice about problems.
curative	A curative medicine or agent. <i>Curative powers of herbal remedies.</i>
cure	A substance or treatment that cures a disease or condition. <i>A bid to trace and cure the gearbox problems.</i>
dialysis	The clinical purification of blood by dialysis as a substitute for the normal function of the kidney.
doctor	Restore by replacing a part or putting together what is torn or broken. <i>She is a doctor of philosophy in physics.</i>
dosage	A measured portion of medicine taken at any one time. <i>There are recommendations about dosage in elderly patients.</i>
healer	Something that alleviates distress or anguish. <i>A spiritual healer and medium.</i>
healing	The natural process by which the body repairs itself. <i>The healing process.</i>
herbal	A book that describes herbs and their culinary and medicinal properties. <i>Herbal remedies.</i>

homeopathy	A method of treating disease with small amounts of remedies that, in large amounts in healthy people, produce symptoms similar to those being treated.
injection	A thing that is injected. <i>A morphine injection.</i>
medicine	Treat medicinally treat with medicine. <i>The remarkable achievements of modern medicine.</i>
nostrum	Hypothetical remedy for all ills or diseases; once sought by the alchemists. <i>A charlatan who sells nostrums.</i>
orthopedic	Of or relating to orthopedics. <i>Orthopedic shoes.</i>
osteopath	A therapist who manipulates the skeleton and muscles.
pharmacopoeia	An official publication containing a list of medicinal drugs with their effects and directions for their use.
podiatrist	A person who treats the feet and their ailments; a chiropodist. <i>If a toe has a discharge it is likely infected and needs to be treated by a podiatrist.</i>
psychiatrist	A medical practitioner specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness.
relaxing	Affording physical or mental rest. <i>The warm water was very relaxing.</i>
remedial	Tending or intended to rectify or improve. <i>Remedial education.</i>
remedy	The margin within which coins as minted may differ from the standard fineness and weight. <i>Compensation is available as a remedy against governmental institutions.</i>
rub	Scrape or rub as if to relieve itching. <i>She rubbed her arm where she had a large bruise.</i>
therapeutic	Administered or applied for reasons of health. <i>A therapeutic silence.</i>
therapist	A person who treats psychological problems a psychotherapist. <i>Cost is one factor keeping them from the therapist s couch.</i>
therapy	The act of caring for someone (as by medication or remedial training etc). <i>The therapy helps the patient to deal with difficult relationships.</i>
