cryptogram	A symbol or figure with secret or occult significance.
<u>cure</u>	Provide a cure for make healthy again. The <b>cure</b> is to improve the clutch operation.
disbelieve	Have no religious faith. <i>He seemed to <b>disbelieve</b> her.</i>
economic	Relating to economics or the economy. <i>He wrote the book primarily for <b>economic</b> reasons.</i>
elixir	A substance believed to cure all ills. <i>At one point during the festivities the river is said to turn into the <b>elixir</b> of <i>life</i>.</i>
<u>enigma</u>	A person or thing that is mysterious or difficult to understand. <i>Madeleine was still an <b>enigma</b> to him.</i>
healing	The process of making or becoming sound or healthy again. <i>The gift of <b>healing</b></i> .
heaven	God (or the gods. <i>Heaven</i> knows.
idle	Cause an engine to idle. He did not want to waste valuable time in <b>idle</b> chatter.
immortality	Perpetual life after death. <i>Eating the fruit gave the gods <b>immortality</b>.</i>



magic	Move change or create by or as if by magic. <i>He s been working his <b>magic</b> on New Zealand movies for the past two decades.</i>
<u>mystery</u>	The practices, skills, or lore peculiar to a particular trade or activity and regarded as baffling to those without specialized knowledge. <i>He s a bit of a mystery said Nina.</i>
<u>mystic</u>	Relating to or characteristic of mysticism. <i>Mystic</i> al theories about the securities market.
<u>occult</u>	Communicated only to the initiated; esoteric. <i>Occult</i> blood in the stool.
panacea	A solution or remedy for all difficulties or diseases. <i>The time honoured <b>panacea</b> cod liver oil.</i>
<u>paradise</u>	The abode of righteous souls after death. Martyrs who die in battle with the ungodly earn instant transmission to <b>paradise</b> .
<u>potion</u>	A medicinal or magical or poisonous beverage. A healing <b>potion</b> .
preternatural	Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature. Beyond his <b>preternatural</b> affability there is some acid and some steel.
<u>puzzle</u>	A jigsaw puzzle. Realization dawned as the pieces of the <b>puzzle</b> fell into place.
resurrection	(in Christian belief) the rising of Christ from the dead. <i>The story of the <b>resurrection</b> of Osiris.</i>
resuscitated	Restored to life or consciousness.
<u>revival</u>	An instance of something becoming popular, active, or important again. <i>The Gothic <b>revival</b> in architecture.</i>
riddle	Speak in or pose riddles. The bullets <b>riddle</b> d his body.
solve	Find the solution. <b>Solve</b> an old debt.
sorcery	The use of magic, especially black magic.
supernatural	Manifestations or events considered to be of supernatural origin such as ghosts. A woman of <b>supernatural</b> beauty.
worker	A person who works at a specific occupation. A farm <b>worker</b> .
