arcane	Understood by few; mysterious or secret. <i>The arcane science of dowsing.</i>
ascension	The ascent of Christ into heaven on the fortieth day after the Resurrection. <i>His ascension to the presidency.</i>
conundrum	A question asked for amusement, typically one with a pun in its answer; a riddle. <i>One of the most difficult conundrums for the experts.</i>
cryptogram	A symbol or figure with secret or occult significance.
cure	Provide a cure for make healthy again. <i>The cure is to improve the clutch operation.</i>
disbelieve	Have no religious faith. <i>He seemed to disbelieve her.</i>
economic	Relating to economics or the economy. <i>He wrote the book primarily for economic reasons.</i>
elixir	A substance believed to cure all ills. <i>At one point during the festivities the river is said to turn into the elixir of life.</i>
enigma	A person or thing that is mysterious or difficult to understand. <i>Madeleine was still an enigma to him.</i>
healing	The process of making or becoming sound or healthy again. <i>The gift of healing.</i>
heaven	God (or the gods). <i>Heaven knows.</i>
idle	Cause an engine to idle. <i>He did not want to waste valuable time in idle chatter.</i>
immortality	Perpetual life after death. <i>Eating the fruit gave the gods immortality.</i>

magic	Move change or create by or as if by magic. <i>He s been working his magic on New Zealand movies for the past two decades.</i>
mystery	The practices, skills, or lore peculiar to a particular trade or activity and regarded as baffling to those without specialized knowledge. <i>He s a bit of a mystery said Nina.</i>
mystic	Relating to or characteristic of mysticism. <i>Mystical theories about the securities market.</i>
occult	Communicated only to the initiated; esoteric. <i>Occult blood in the stool.</i>
panacea	A solution or remedy for all difficulties or diseases. <i>The time honoured panacea cod liver oil.</i>
paradise	The abode of righteous souls after death. <i>Martyrs who die in battle with the ungodly earn instant transmission to paradise.</i>
potion	A medicinal or magical or poisonous beverage. <i>A healing potion.</i>
preternatural	Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature. <i>Beyond his preternatural affability there is some acid and some steel.</i>
puzzle	A jigsaw puzzle. <i>Realization dawned as the pieces of the puzzle fell into place.</i>
resurrection	(in Christian belief) the rising of Christ from the dead. <i>The story of the resurrection of Osiris.</i>
resuscitated	Restored to life or consciousness.
revival	An instance of something becoming popular, active, or important again. <i>The Gothic revival in architecture.</i>
riddle	Speak in or pose riddles. <i>The bullets riddled his body.</i>
solve	Find the solution. <i>Solve an old debt.</i>
sorcery	The use of magic, especially black magic.
supernatural	Manifestations or events considered to be of supernatural origin such as ghosts. <i>A woman of supernatural beauty.</i>
worker	A person who works at a specific occupation. <i>A farm worker.</i>
