<a href="#">conundrum</a>	A question asked for amusement, typically one with a pun in its answer; a riddle. <i>One of the most difficult <b>conundrums</b> for the experts.</i>
<b>cryptogram</b>	A symbol or figure with secret or occult significance.
<a href="#">cure</a>	Provide a cure for make healthy again. <i>The <b>cure</b> is to improve the clutch operation.</i>
<b>disbelieve</b>	Have no religious faith. <i>He seemed to <b>disbelieve</b> her.</i>
<b>economic</b>	Relating to economics or the economy. <i>He wrote the book primarily for <b>economic</b> reasons.</i>
<b>elixir</b>	A substance believed to cure all ills. <i>At one point during the festivities the river is said to turn into the <b>elixir</b> of life.</i>
<a href="#">enigma</a>	A person or thing that is mysterious or difficult to understand. <i>Madeleine was still an <b>enigma</b> to him.</i>
<b>healing</b>	The process of making or becoming sound or healthy again. <i>The gift of <b>healing</b>.</i>
<b>heaven</b>	God (or the gods). <i><b>Heaven</b> knows.</i>
<b>idle</b>	Cause an engine to idle. <i>He did not want to waste valuable time in <b>idle</b> chatter.</i>
<b>immortality</b>	Perpetual life after death. <i>Eating the fruit gave the gods <b>immortality</b>.</i>

<b>magic</b>	Move change or create by or as if by magic. <i>He s been working his <b>magic</b> on New Zealand movies for the past two decades.</i>
<b>mystery</b>	The practices, skills, or lore peculiar to a particular trade or activity and regarded as baffling to those without specialized knowledge. <i>He s a bit of a <b>mystery</b> said Nina.</i>
<b>mystic</b>	Relating to or characteristic of mysticism. <i><b>Mystical</b> theories about the securities market.</i>
<b>occult</b>	Communicated only to the initiated; esoteric. <i><b>Occult</b> blood in the stool.</i>
<b>panacea</b>	A solution or remedy for all difficulties or diseases. <i>The time honoured <b>panacea</b> cod liver oil.</i>
<b>paradise</b>	The abode of righteous souls after death. <i>Martyrs who die in battle with the ungodly earn instant transmission to <b>paradise</b>.</i>
<b>potion</b>	A medicinal or magical or poisonous beverage. <i>A healing <b>potion</b>.</i>
<b>preternatural</b>	Existing outside of or not in accordance with nature. <i>Beyond his <b>preternatural</b> affability there is some acid and some steel.</i>
<b>puzzle</b>	A jigsaw puzzle. <i>Realization dawned as the pieces of the <b>puzzle</b> fell into place.</i>
<b>resurrection</b>	(in Christian belief) the rising of Christ from the dead. <i>The story of the <b>resurrection</b> of Osiris.</i>
<b>resuscitated</b>	Restored to life or consciousness.
<b>revival</b>	An instance of something becoming popular, active, or important again. <i>The Gothic <b>revival</b> in architecture.</i>
<b>riddle</b>	Speak in or pose riddles. <i>The bullets <b>riddled</b> his body.</i>
<b>solve</b>	Find the solution. <i><b>Solve</b> an old debt.</i>
<b>sorcery</b>	The use of magic, especially black magic.
<b>supernatural</b>	Manifestations or events considered to be of supernatural origin such as ghosts. <i>A woman of <b>supernatural</b> beauty.</i>
<b>worker</b>	A person who works at a specific occupation. <i>A farm <b>worker</b>.</i>
