Associations of "For orange" (30 Words)

apple	Used in names of unrelated fruits or other plant growths that resemble apples in some way e g custard apple oak apple.
berry	A small fruit having any of various structures e g simple grape or blueberry or aggregate blackberry or raspberry. <i>We went berrying in the summer.</i>
brown	A satyrid butterfly which typically has brown wings with small eyespots. <i>An old brown coat.</i>
chevron	V-shaped sleeve badge indicating military rank and service.
citrus	A tree of a genus that includes citron lemon lime orange and grapefruit Native to Asia citrus trees are cultivated in warm countries for their fruit. <i>Citrus extracts.</i>
coconut	Tall palm tree bearing coconuts as fruits widely planted throughout the tropics. <i>Coconut shells.</i>
colored	(used of color) artificially produced; not natural. <i>Colored crepe paper.</i>
dye	Take colour well or badly during the dyeing process. <i>Please dye these shoes.</i>
grapevine	A vine native to both Eurasia and North America, especially one bearing grapes used for eating or winemaking. <i>I d heard on the grapevine that the business was nearly settled.</i>
gray	Horse of a light gray or whitish color. <i>Gray flannel suit.</i>
juice	Extract the juice from fruit or vegetables. <i>I know there are 82 players on the juice.</i>
juicy	Lucrative. <i>A juicy contract.</i>

lemon	A distinctive tart flavor characteristic of lemons. <i>Lemon juice.</i>
marbled	(especially of paper) having a streaked and patterned appearance like that of variegated marble. <i>Attractively marbled cloth or paper.</i>
marmalade	A preserve made of the pulp and rind of citrus fruits.
paint	Having sections or patches colored differently and usually brightly. <i>Her rouged cheeks and paint lips.</i>
peach	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. <i>It was another peach of a day.</i>
pear	The Eurasian tree which bears the pear.
persimmon	The tree which yields the persimmon related to ebony.
pigmentation	Coloration of living tissues by pigment.
polychrome	Color with many colors make polychrome. <i>Painters gilded and polychromed the wooden carvings.</i>
red	A red wine. <i>A bottle of red.</i>
rind	The hard outer edge of cheese or bacon. <i>Decorate with fine shreds of orange rind.</i>
scarlet	Scarlet clothes or material. <i>Papers lettered in scarlet and black.</i>
spotted	Having spots or patches (small areas of contrasting color or texture). <i>A red spotted handkerchief.</i>
strawberry	The low growing plant which produces the strawberry having white flowers lobed leaves and runners and found throughout north temperate regions. <i>She thought she would wear the strawberry crushed velvet.</i>
stripe	Mark with stripes. <i>Her body was striped with bands of sunlight.</i>
striped	Marked with or having stripes. <i>A green striped coat.</i>
tangerine	The citrus tree which bears the tangerine. <i>A tangerine evening gown.</i>
yellow	Yellow colour or pigment. <i>The little yellow stain of treason.</i>
