## Associations of "For orange" (30 Words)

<b>apple</b>	Used in names of unrelated fruits or other plant growths that resemble apples in some way e g custard apple oak apple.
<a href="#">berry</a>	A small fruit having any of various structures e g simple grape or blueberry or aggregate blackberry or raspberry. <i>We went <b>berrying</b> in the summer.</i>
<a href="#">brown</a>	A satyrid butterfly which typically has brown wings with small eyespots. <i>An old <b>brown</b> coat.</i>
<b>chevron</b>	V-shaped sleeve badge indicating military rank and service.
<b>citrus</b>	A tree of a genus that includes citron lemon lime orange and grapefruit Native to Asia citrus trees are cultivated in warm countries for their fruit. <i><b>Citrus</b> extracts.</i>
<b>coconut</b>	Tall palm tree bearing coconuts as fruits widely planted throughout the tropics. <i><b>Coconut</b> shells.</i>
<b>colored</b>	(used of color) artificially produced; not natural. <i><b>Colored</b> crepe paper.</i>
<b>dye</b>	Take colour well or badly during the dyeing process. <i>Please <b>dye</b> these shoes.</i>
<b>grapevine</b>	A vine native to both Eurasia and North America, especially one bearing grapes used for eating or winemaking. <i>I d heard on the <b>grapevine</b> that the business was nearly settled.</i>
<b>gray</b>	Horse of a light gray or whitish color. <i><b>Gray</b> flannel suit.</i>
<b>juice</b>	Extract the juice from fruit or vegetables. <i>I know there are 82 players on the <b>juice</b>.</i>
<a href="#">juicy</a>	Lucrative. <i>A <b>juicy</b> contract.</i>

<b>lemon</b>	A distinctive tart flavor characteristic of lemons. <i><b>Lemon</b> juice.</i>
<b>marbled</b>	(especially of paper) having a streaked and patterned appearance like that of variegated marble. <i>Attractively <b>marbled</b> cloth or paper.</i>
<b>marmalade</b>	A preserve made of the pulp and rind of citrus fruits.
<b>paint</b>	Having sections or patches colored differently and usually brightly. <i>Her rouged cheeks and <b>paint</b> lips.</i>
<b>peach</b>	A pinkish yellow colour like that of a peach. <i>It was another <b>peach</b> of a day.</i>
<b>pear</b>	The Eurasian tree which bears the pear.
<b>persimmon</b>	The tree which yields the persimmon related to ebony.
<b>pigmentation</b>	Coloration of living tissues by pigment.
<b>polychrome</b>	Color with many colors make polychrome. <i>Painters gilded and <b>polychromed</b> the wooden carvings.</i>
<b>red</b>	A red wine. <i>A bottle of <b>red</b>.</i>
<b>rind</b>	The hard outer edge of cheese or bacon. <i>Decorate with fine shreds of orange <b>rind</b>.</i>
<b>scarlet</b>	Scarlet clothes or material. <i>Papers lettered in <b>scarlet</b> and black.</i>
<b>spotted</b>	Having spots or patches (small areas of contrasting color or texture). <i>A red <b>spotted</b> handkerchief.</i>
<b>strawberry</b>	The low growing plant which produces the strawberry having white flowers lobed leaves and runners and found throughout north temperate regions. <i>She thought she would wear the <b>strawberry</b> crushed velvet.</i>
<b>stripe</b>	Mark with stripes. <i>Her body was <b>striped</b> with bands of sunlight.</i>
<b>striped</b>	Marked with or having stripes. <i>A green <b>striped</b> coat.</i>
<b>tangerine</b>	The citrus tree which bears the tangerine. <i>A <b>tangerine</b> evening gown.</i>
<b>yellow</b>	Yellow colour or pigment. <i>The little <b>yellow</b> stain of treason.</i>
