alluvial	Of or relating to alluvium. <i>Rich alluvial soils.</i>
aquifer	Underground bed or layer yielding ground water for wells and springs etc.
auricular	Pertaining to an auricle of the heart. <i>The Catholic doctrine of the necessity of private auricular confession.</i>
bombast	High-sounding language with little meaning, used to impress people. <i>The bombast of gung ho militarism.</i>
constricted	Narrowed, especially by encircling pressure. <i>A constricted view of life.</i>
crossing	The action of crossing something. <i>A short ferry crossing.</i>
crosswalk	A path (often marked) where something (as a street or railroad) can be crossed to get from one side to the other.
dabbler	Any of numerous shallow-water ducks that feed by upending and dabbling.
depth	Degree of psychological or intellectual profundity. <i>The depth of his sighs.</i>
dilettante	An amateur who engages in an activity without serious intentions and who pretends to have knowledge. <i>A wealthy literary dilettante.</i>
<u>external</u>	Coming from the outside. <i>For external application only.</i>
externalize	Project (a mental image or process) on to a figure outside oneself. <i>An urgent need to externalize the experience.</i>
ford	A shallow area in a stream that can be forded.
fordable	Shallow enough to be crossed by walking or riding on an animal or in a vehicle. <i>The stream was fordable.</i>

integument	An outer protective covering such as the skin of an animal or a cuticle or seed coat or rind or shell. <i>This chemical compound is found in the integument of the seed.</i>
layer	Propagate a plant as a layer. <i>A simile has at least two layers of meaning.</i>
narrowed	Reduced in size as by squeezing together. <i>A narrowed view of the world.</i>
ostensible	Appearing as such but not necessarily so. <i>The real dispute which lay behind the ostensible complaint.</i>
outer	An outer garment or part of one. <i>Spent hours adorning the outer man.</i>
outward	Outwards. <i>Outward bound ships.</i>
packed	Extremely crowded or filled to capacity. <i>Packed snow.</i>
river	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea a lake or another river. <i>River pollution.</i>
seeming	Appearing to be real or true, but not necessarily being so; apparent. <i>That dissidence between inward reality and outward seeming.</i>
shoal	Of fish form shoals. <i>A shoal of bream.</i>
smatter	Work with in an amateurish manner. <i>She smatters Russian.</i>
stratify	Of seeds be germinated by stratifying. <i>Stratify seeds.</i>
stream	The act of flowing or streaming continuous progression. <i>His nose streamed blood.</i>
superficial	Appearing to be true or real only until examined more closely. <i>His thinking was superficial and fuzzy.</i>
surface	Put a coat on cover the surface of furnish with a surface. <i>The surface fleet.</i>
underground	A member of an underground political group or movement. <i>Underground caverns.</i>
