## Associations of "For shallow" (30 Words)

<b>alluvial</b>	Of or relating to alluvium. <i>Rich <b>alluvial</b> soils.</i>
<b>aquifer</b>	Underground bed or layer yielding ground water for wells and springs etc.
<b>auricular</b>	Pertaining to an auricle of the heart. <i>The Catholic doctrine of the necessity of private <b>auricular</b> confession.</i>
<b>bombast</b>	High-sounding language with little meaning, used to impress people. <i>The <b>bombast</b> of gung ho militarism.</i>
<b>constricted</b>	Narrowed, especially by encircling pressure. <i>A <b>constricted</b> view of life.</i>
<b>crossing</b>	The action of crossing something. <i>A short ferry <b>crossing</b>.</i>
<b>crosswalk</b>	A path (often marked) where something (as a street or railroad) can be crossed to get from one side to the other.
<b>dabbler</b>	Any of numerous shallow-water ducks that feed by upending and dabbling.
<b>depth</b>	Degree of psychological or intellectual profundity. <i>The <b>depth</b> of his sighs.</i>
<b>dilettante</b>	An amateur who engages in an activity without serious intentions and who pretends to have knowledge. <i>A wealthy literary <b>dilettante</b>.</i>
<b><u>external</u></b>	Coming from the outside. <i>For <b>external</b> application only.</i>
<b>externalize</b>	Project (a mental image or process) on to a figure outside oneself. <i>An urgent need to <b>externalize</b> the experience.</i>
<b>ford</b>	A shallow area in a stream that can be forded.
<b>fordable</b>	Shallow enough to be crossed by walking or riding on an animal or in a vehicle. <i>The stream was <b>fordable</b>.</i>

<b>integument</b>	An outer protective covering such as the skin of an animal or a cuticle or seed coat or rind or shell. <i>This chemical compound is found in the <b>integument</b> of the seed.</i>
<b>layer</b>	Propagate a plant as a layer. <i>A simile has at least two <b>layers</b> of meaning.</i>
<b>narrowed</b>	Reduced in size as by squeezing together. <i>A <b>narrowed</b> view of the world.</i>
<b>ostensible</b>	Appearing as such but not necessarily so. <i>The real dispute which lay behind the <b>ostensible</b> complaint.</i>
<b>outer</b>	An outer garment or part of one. <i>Spent hours adorning the <b>outer</b> man.</i>
<b>outward</b>	Outwards. <i><b>Outward</b> bound ships.</i>
<b>packed</b>	Extremely crowded or filled to capacity. <i><b>Packed</b> snow.</i>
<b>river</b>	A large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea a lake or another river. <i><b>River</b> pollution.</i>
<b>seeming</b>	Appearing to be real or true, but not necessarily being so; apparent. <i>That dissidence between inward reality and outward <b>seeming</b>.</i>
<b>shoal</b>	Of fish form shoals. <i>A <b>shoal</b> of bream.</i>
<b>smatter</b>	Work with in an amateurish manner. <i>She <b>smatters</b> Russian.</i>
<b>stratify</b>	Of seeds be germinated by stratifying. <i><b>Stratify</b> seeds.</i>
<b>stream</b>	The act of flowing or streaming continuous progression. <i>His nose <b>streamed</b> blood.</i>
<b>superficial</b>	Appearing to be true or real only until examined more closely. <i>His thinking was <b>superficial</b> and fuzzy.</i>
<b>surface</b>	Put a coat on cover the surface of furnish with a surface. <i>The <b>surface</b> fleet.</i>
<b>underground</b>	A member of an underground political group or movement. <i><b>Underground</b> caverns.</i>
