Associations of "For spooky" (30 Words)

<u>afraid</u>	Feeling fear or anxiety; frightened. <i>Terribly afraid of offending someone.</i>
<u>alarming</u>	Worrying or disturbing. <i>Our countryside is disappearing at an alarming rate.</i>
appall	Fill with apprehension or alarm; cause to be unpleasantly surprised.
<u>appalling</u>	Causing shock or dismay; horrific. <i>Appalling conditions.</i>
<u>astounding</u>	So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm. <i>The summit offers astounding views.</i>
<u>atrocious</u>	Exceptionally bad or displeasing. <i>Atrocious weather.</i>
<u>diabolical</u>	Characteristic of the Devil, or so evil as to be suggestive of the Devil. <i>The diabolical expression on his face.</i>
<u>dreadful</u>	Extremely disagreeable. <i>You re a dreadful flirt.</i>
eerie	Strange and frightening. <i>An eerie midnight howl.</i>
<u>excitable</u>	Capable of responding to stimuli. <i>A rather excitable young man.</i>
fearful	Causing or likely to cause people to be afraid; horrifying. <i>He was in a fearful hurry.</i>
fearfulness	An emotion experienced in anticipation of some specific pain or danger (usually accompanied by a desire to flee or fight).
fright	Frighten. <i>Ghosts could never affright her.</i>
<u>frightening</u>	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>A frightening experience.</i>

frightful	Extreme in degree or extent or amount or impact. <i>There s been a most frightful accident.</i>
ghastly	Extremely unwell. <i>One of the most ghastly crimes ever committed.</i>
grisly	Causing horror or disgust. <i>A grisly murder.</i>
gruesome	Extremely unpleasant. <i>Gruesome catering.</i>
hellish	Extremely (used for emphasis). <i>Hellish torture.</i>
hideous	Grossly offensive to decency or morality; causing horror. <i>The whole hideous story.</i>
horrific	Causing horror. <i>Horrific conditions in the mining industry.</i>
horrifying	Causing horror; extremely shocking. <i>An alarming even horrifying picture.</i>
horror	A literary or film genre concerned with arousing feelings of horror. <i>The mere thought of it gives me the horrors.</i>
macabre	Shockingly repellent; inspiring horror. <i>Macabre tales of war and plague in the Middle ages.</i>
scared	Fearful; frightened. <i>He s scared to come to you and ask for help.</i>
scary	Provoking fear terror. <i>It was scary the way they bonded with each other.</i>
skittish	(of a person) playfully frivolous or unpredictable. <i>A skittish chestnut mare.</i>
spectral	Of or relating to a spectrum. <i>A spectral menacing face.</i>
terrible	Causing fear or dread or terror. <i>A terrible curse.</i>
terrifying	Causing extreme terror. <i>The terrifying events of the past few weeks.</i>
