changeless	Unvarying in nature. <i>Changeless truths.</i>
confirmed	(of a person) firmly established in a particular habit, belief, or way of life and unlikely to change their ways. <i>A confirmed Catholic.</i>
constancy	(psychology) the tendency for perceived objects to give rise to very similar perceptual experiences in spite of wide variations in the conditions of observation. <i>Early mariners relied on the constancy of the trade winds.</i>
constant	A number representing a quantity assumed to have a fixed value in a specified mathematical context. <i>Maintained a constant temperature.</i>
durability	Permanence by virtue of the power to resist stress or force. <i>The reliability and durability of plastics.</i>
 durable	Very long lasting. <i>A durable peace can be achieved.</i>
fixed	Of a number having a fixed and unchanging value. <i>The fight s fixed the ref has your card marked.</i>
immobile	Securely fixed in place. <i>An immobile workforce.</i>
immobility	Remaining in place. <i>The disorder is caused by long periods of immobility.</i>
immovable	Immovable property. <i>An immovable article of faith.</i>
immutable	Constant and unchanging. <i>The immutable laws of nature.</i>

indelible	Cannot be removed or erased. <i>The story made an indelible impression on me.</i>
indestructible	Not easily destroyed. <i>Indestructible plastic containers.</i>
invariable	A quantity that does not vary. <i>His routine was invariable.</i>
lasting	Lasting a long time without change. <i>A long lasting friendship.</i>
sedentary	Requiring sitting or little activity. <i>A sedentary lifestyle spells bad news for hips and thighs.</i>
settled	Established or decided beyond dispute or doubt. <i>Settled areas.</i>
stability	The state of being stable. <i>There are fears for the political stability of the area.</i>
standing	Executed in or initiated from a standing position. <i>A standing committee.</i>
static	Relating to statics. <i>The whole ballet appeared too static.</i>
statics	The branch of mechanics concerned with bodies at rest and forces in equilibrium.
steadfast	Marked by firm determination or resolution; not shakable. <i>Steadfast loyalty.</i>
steady	Support or hold steady and make steadfast with or as if with a brace. <i>A steady gaze.</i>
stiff	In a stiff manner. <i>His hands lay stiffly.</i>
unchangeable	Not changeable or subject to change. <i>A fixed and unchangeable part of the germ plasm.</i>
unchanging	Not changing; remaining the same. <i>The party stood for unchanging principles.</i>
unmoving	Not arousing emotions. <i>This must be the most unmoving performance of Verdi's opera ever recorded.</i>
unswerving	Firm and dependable especially in loyalty. <i>Unswerving loyalty.</i>
unwavering	Not showing abrupt variations- Louis Auchincloss. <i>She fixed him with an unwavering stare.</i>
