<b>acceptable</b>	Able to be agreed on; suitable. <i>Pollution in the city had reached four times the <b>acceptable</b> level.</i>
<b>adequacy</b>	The quality of being able to meet a need satisfactorily. <i>The <b>adequacy</b> of testing procedures.</i>
<b>adequate</b>	About average; acceptable. <i><b>Adequate</b> resources and funding.</i>
<b><u>affordable</u></b>	That you have the financial means for. <i><b>Affordable</b> homes.</i>
<b>aligning</b>	Causing to fall into line or into position.
<b>ample</b>	Large and accommodating. <i>An <b>ample</b> waistline.</i>
<b>appropriate</b>	Take possession of by force, as after an invasion. <i>It seems that an apology is <b>appropriate</b>.</i>
<b>compatibility</b>	A feeling of sympathy and friendship; like-mindedness. <i>Software <b>compatibility</b> is another important factor to consider.</i>
<b>compatible</b>	(of one thing) consistent with another. <i>It s a pity we re not <b>compatible</b>.</i>
<b>conformable</b>	Similar in form or nature; consistent. <i>I have been to you a true and humble wife at all times to your will <b>conformable</b>.</i>
<b>congruous</b>	In agreement or harmony. <i>This explanation is <b>congruous</b> with earlier observations.</i>
<b><u>decent</u></b>	Decently clothed. <i>A <b>decent</b> burial.</i>
<b>eligible</b>	Qualified for or allowed or worthy of being chosen. <i>An <b>eligible</b> bachelor.</i>

<b>enough</b>	An adequate quantity a quantity that is large enough to achieve a purpose. <i>Curiously <b>enough</b> this is not a new phenomenon.</i>
<b>fit</b>	Be the right size or shape fit correctly or as desired. <i>The shoes <b>fitted</b> better after being stretched.</i>
<b>germane</b>	Relevant to a subject under consideration. <i>He asks questions that are <b>germane</b> and central to the issue.</i>
<b>harmonious</b>	Free from disagreement or dissent. <i><b>Harmonious</b> family relationships.</i>
<b>identical</b>	(of twins) derived from a single egg or ovum. <i>Cars <b>identical</b> except for their license plates.</i>
<b>inoffensive</b>	Giving no offense. <i>A quiet <b>inoffensive</b> man.</i>
<b>moderation</b>	The avoidance of excess or extremes, especially in one's behaviour or political opinions. <i>Coursework may need to be filed separately for the purposes of <b>moderation</b>.</i>
<b>proper</b>	Appropriate for a condition or purpose or occasion or a person's character, needs. <i>Everything in its <b>proper</b> place.</i>
<b>properly</b>	Appropriately for the circumstances; suitably or respectably. <i>Please do your job <b>properly</b>.</i>
<b>propriety</b>	Correct or appropriate behavior. <i>They questioned the <b>propriety</b> of certain investments made by the council.</i>
<b>relevancy</b>	The relation of something to the matter at hand.
<b>relevant</b>	Appropriate to the current time, period, or circumstances; of contemporary interest. <i>Critics may find themselves unable to stay <b>relevant</b> in a changing world.</i>
<b>sufficiency</b>	Self sufficiency or independence of character especially of an arrogant or imperious sort. <i>He questioned the <b>sufficiency</b> of human intelligence.</i>
<b>suitability</b>	The quality of having the properties that are right for a specific purpose. <i>An important requirement is <b>suitability</b> for long trips.</i>
<b>symphonic</b>	Relating to or written for a symphony orchestra. <i>The <b>symphonic</b> hum of a million insects.</i>
<b>unobjectionable</b>	Not objectionable; acceptable. <i><b>Unobjectionable</b> behavior.</i>

**validation**

Recognition or affirmation that a person or their feelings or opinions are valid or worthwhile.

*The technique requires **validation** in controlled trials.*
