Associations of "For suitable" (30 Words)

acceptable	Able to be agreed on; suitable. <i>Pollution in the city had reached four times the acceptable level.</i>
adequacy	The quality of being able to meet a need satisfactorily. <i>The adequacy of testing procedures.</i>
adequate	About average; acceptable. <i>Adequate resources and funding.</i>
affordable	That you have the financial means for. <i>Affordable homes.</i>
aligning	Causing to fall into line or into position.
ample	Large and accommodating. <i>An ample waistline.</i>
appropriate	Take possession of by force, as after an invasion. <i>It seems that an apology is appropriate.</i>
compatibility	A feeling of sympathy and friendship; like-mindedness. <i>Software compatibility is another important factor to consider.</i>
compatible	(of one thing) consistent with another. <i>It s a pity we re not compatible.</i>
conformable	Similar in form or nature; consistent. <i>I have been to you a true and humble wife at all times to your will conformable.</i>
congruous	In agreement or harmony. <i>This explanation is congruous with earlier observations.</i>
decent	Decently clothed. <i>A decent burial.</i>
eligible	Qualified for or allowed or worthy of being chosen. <i>An eligible bachelor.</i>

enough	An adequate quantity a quantity that is large enough to achieve a purpose. <i>Curiously enough this is not a new phenomenon.</i>
fit	Be the right size or shape fit correctly or as desired. <i>The shoes fitted better after being stretched.</i>
germane	Relevant to a subject under consideration. <i>He asks questions that are germane and central to the issue.</i>
harmonious	Free from disagreement or dissent. <i>Harmonious family relationships.</i>
identical	(of twins) derived from a single egg or ovum. <i>Cars identical except for their license plates.</i>
inoffensive	Giving no offense. <i>A quiet inoffensive man.</i>
moderation	The avoidance of excess or extremes, especially in one's behaviour or political opinions. <i>Coursework may need to be filed separately for the purposes of moderation.</i>
proper	Appropriate for a condition or purpose or occasion or a person's character, needs. <i>Everything in its proper place.</i>
properly	Appropriately for the circumstances; suitably or respectably. <i>Please do your job properly.</i>
propriety	Correct or appropriate behavior. <i>They questioned the propriety of certain investments made by the council.</i>
relevancy	The relation of something to the matter at hand.
relevant	Appropriate to the current time, period, or circumstances; of contemporary interest. <i>Critics may find themselves unable to stay relevant in a changing world.</i>
sufficiency	Self sufficiency or independence of character especially of an arrogant or imperious sort. <i>He questioned the sufficiency of human intelligence.</i>
suitability	The quality of having the properties that are right for a specific purpose. <i>An important requirement is suitability for long trips.</i>
symphonic	Relating to or written for a symphony orchestra. <i>The symphonic hum of a million insects.</i>
unobjectionable	Not objectionable; acceptable. <i>Unobjectionable behavior.</i>

validation

Recognition or affirmation that a person or their feelings or opinions are valid or worthwhile.

*The technique requires **validation** in controlled trials.*
