<b>accomplished</b>	Settled securely and unconditionally. <i>A very elegant and <b>accomplished</b> person.</i>
<b>adept</b>	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>An <b>adept</b> negotiator.</i>
<b>adroit</b>	Clever or skilful. <i>An <b>adroit</b> negotiator.</i>
<b>artistry</b>	Creative skill or ability. <i>The <b>artistry</b> of the pianist.</i>
<b>bravura</b>	Brilliant and showy technical skill. <i>The music ends with a display of <b>bravura</b>.</i>
<b>competence</b>	Effective performance of the normal function. <i>Courses to improve the <b>competence</b> of staff.</i>
<b>competent</b>	Legally qualified or sufficient. <i>A <b>competent</b> typist.</i>
<b><a href="#">craft</a></b>	An aircraft or spaceship. <i>A carefully <b>crafted</b> peace process.</i>
<b><a href="#">deft</a></b>	Demonstrating skill and cleverness. <i><b>Deft</b> fingers massaged her face.</i>
<b>dexterous</b>	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. <i><b>Dexterous</b> of hand and inventive of mind.</i>
<b>expert</b>	A person with special knowledge or ability who performs skillfully. <i>An <b>expert</b> job.</i>
<b><a href="#">guru</a></b>	A recognized leader in some field or of some movement. <i>A <b>guru</b> of genomics.</i>
<b>maven</b>	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>The <b>maven</b> of vintage furniture.</i>

<b>practiced</b>	Having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude. <i>A <b>practiced</b> marksman.</i>
<b>professionalism</b>	The practising of an activity, especially a sport, by professional rather than amateur players. <i>The trend towards <b>professionalism</b>.</i>
<b>proficiency</b>	A high degree of skill; expertise. <i>He demonstrated his <b>proficiency</b> in Chinese.</i>
<b>proficient</b>	A person who is proficient. <i>She felt reasonably <b>proficient</b> in Italian.</i>
<b>repairman</b>	A skilled worker whose job is to repair things. <i>A TV <b>repairman</b>.</i>
<u><b>seasoned</b></u>	Accustomed to particular conditions; experienced. <i>A <b>seasoned</b> traveler.</i>
<b>skilled</b>	Having or showing the knowledge, ability, or training to perform a certain activity or task well. <i><b>Skilled</b> legal advice.</i>
<b>skillful</b>	Having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude. <i>A lesser known but no less <b>skillful</b> composer.</i>
<b>software</b>	Written programs or procedures or rules and associated documentation pertaining to the operation of a computer system and that are stored in read/write memory. <i>The <b>software</b> industry.</i>
<b>specialty</b>	A distinguishing trait.
<b>tanner</b>	A small coin of the United Kingdom worth six pennies; not minted since 1970. <i>Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless <b>tanners</b>.</i>
<b>technician</b>	Someone known for high skill in some intellectual or artistic technique. <i>Liszt was one of the greatest piano <b>technicians</b> of all time.</i>
<b>technique</b>	Skill or ability in a particular field. <i>New surgical <b>techniques</b> mean a shorter hospital stay.</i>
<b>toolmaker</b>	Someone skilled in making or repairing tools.
<u><b>veteran</b></u>	A person who has had long experience in a particular field. <i>A <b>veteran</b> left wing MP.</i>
<b>virtuosity</b>	Technical skill or fluency or style exhibited by a virtuoso. <i>A performance of considerable <b>virtuosity</b>.</i>

**workmanship** Skill in an occupation or trade.
