accomplished	Settled securely and unconditionally. <i>A very elegant and accomplished person.</i>
adept	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>An adept negotiator.</i>
adroit	Clever or skilful. <i>An adroit negotiator.</i>
artistry	Creative skill or ability. <i>The artistry of the pianist.</i>
bravura	Brilliant and showy technical skill. <i>The music ends with a display of bravura.</i>
competence	Effective performance of the normal function. <i>Courses to improve the competence of staff.</i>
competent	Legally qualified or sufficient. <i>A competent typist.</i>
<u>craft</u>	An aircraft or spaceship. <i>A carefully crafted peace process.</i>
<u>deft</u>	Demonstrating skill and cleverness. <i>Deft fingers massaged her face.</i>
dexterous	Skillful in physical movements; especially of the hands. <i>Dexterous of hand and inventive of mind.</i>
expert	A person with special knowledge or ability who performs skillfully. <i>An expert job.</i>
<u>guru</u>	A recognized leader in some field or of some movement. <i>A guru of genomics.</i>
maven	Someone who is dazzlingly skilled in any field. <i>The maven of vintage furniture.</i>

practiced	Having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude. <i>A practiced marksman.</i>
professionalism	The practising of an activity, especially a sport, by professional rather than amateur players. <i>The trend towards professionalism.</i>
proficiency	A high degree of skill; expertise. <i>He demonstrated his proficiency in Chinese.</i>
proficient	A person who is proficient. <i>She felt reasonably proficient in Italian.</i>
repairman	A skilled worker whose job is to repair things. <i>A TV repairman.</i>
<u>seasoned</u>	Accustomed to particular conditions; experienced. <i>A seasoned traveler.</i>
skilled	Having or showing the knowledge, ability, or training to perform a certain activity or task well. <i>Skilled legal advice.</i>
skillful	Having or showing knowledge and skill and aptitude. <i>A lesser known but no less skillful composer.</i>
software	Written programs or procedures or rules and associated documentation pertaining to the operation of a computer system and that are stored in read/write memory. <i>The software industry.</i>
specialty	A distinguishing trait.
tanner	A small coin of the United Kingdom worth six pennies; not minted since 1970. <i>Skincare companies are coming to the rescue of consumers with sunless tanners.</i>
technician	Someone known for high skill in some intellectual or artistic technique. <i>Liszt was one of the greatest piano technicians of all time.</i>
technique	Skill or ability in a particular field. <i>New surgical techniques mean a shorter hospital stay.</i>
toolmaker	Someone skilled in making or repairing tools.
<u>veteran</u>	A person who has had long experience in a particular field. <i>A veteran left wing MP.</i>
virtuosity	Technical skill or fluency or style exhibited by a virtuoso. <i>A performance of considerable virtuosity.</i>

workmanship Skill in an occupation or trade.
*Cracks on the motorway were caused by poor **workmanship**.*
