accountability	Responsibility to someone or for some activity. Lack of accountability has corroded public respect for business and political leaders.

<u>candid</u>	(of a photograph of a person) taken informally, especially without the subject's knowledge. A candid interview.
<u>candor</u>	Ability to make judgments free from discrimination or dishonesty.
<u>clarity</u>	Free from obscurity and easy to understand; the comprehensibility of clear expression. <i>The clarity of the picture.</i>
<u>clear</u>	Make free from confusion or ambiguity make clear. The following Saturday Mattie had a clear day.
crystalline	Consisting of or containing or of the nature of crystals. The cold crystalline water of melted snow.
diaphanous	So thin as to transmit light. A hat with a diaphanous veil.
directness	The quality of being plain and straightforward. <i>He was renowned for the clarity and directness of his sermons.</i>
forthrightness	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
<u>friendliness</u>	A feeling of liking for another person; enjoyment in their company. I was overwhelmed by the friendliness of the people here.
<u>glass</u>	Enclose with glass. The inn has a long gallery now glass ed in.
glassy	(of sound) resembling the sharp noise made when glass is struck. <i>The glassy surface of the lake.</i>



guileless	Free of deceit. <i>His face once so open and guileless.</i>
<u>honest</u>	Without dissimulation; frank. Good honest food with no gimmicks.
<u>honesty</u>	A European plant with purple or white flowers and round, flat, translucent seed pods which are used for indoor flower arrangements. <i>They spoke with convincing honesty about their fears.</i>
integrity	An undivided or unbroken completeness or totality with nothing wanting. Upholding territorial integrity and national sovereignty.
limpid	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. Could see the sand on the bottom of the limpid pool.
<u>lucid</u>	Showing or having the ability to think clearly, especially in intervals between periods of confusion or insanity. <i>A pellucid brook.</i>
<u>naive</u>	Of or created by one without formal training simple or naive in style. A teenager s naive ignorance of life.
<u>openness</u>	Characterized by an attitude of ready accessibility (especially about one's actions or purposes); without concealment; not secretive. <i>The openness</i> of the prairies.
pellucid	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i>His pellucid singing tone.</i>
perspicuity	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
perspicuous	Clearly expressed and easily understood; lucid. A perspicuous argument.
plain	Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness. Everyone dined at a plain wooden table.
<u>pure</u>	Being chromatically pure not diluted with white or grey or black. <i>Pure</i> oxygen.
simple	(botany) of leaf shapes; of leaves having no divisions or subdivisions. A simple country schoolhouse.
translucent	(of a substance) allowing light, but not detailed shapes, to pass through; semi-transparent. Translucent amber.
transparency	The quality of being clear and transparent. The transparency of ice.
vaporous	So thin as to transmit light. The terminology is rather vaporous .
