Associations of "For transparent" (30 Words)

	Responsibility to someone or for some activity.
accountability	<i>Lack of accountability has corroded public respect for business and political leaders.</i>
acrylic	An acrylic textile fibre. <i>A red acrylic jumper.</i>
candid	(of a photograph of a person) taken informally, especially without the subject's knowledge. <i>A candid interview.</i>
candor	Ability to make judgments free from discrimination or dishonesty.
clarity	Free from obscurity and easy to understand; the comprehensibility of clear expression. <i>The clarity of the picture.</i>
clear	Make free from confusion or ambiguity make clear. <i>The following Saturday Mattie had a clear day.</i>
crystalline	Consisting of or containing or of the nature of crystals. <i>The cold crystalline water of melted snow.</i>
diaphanous	So thin as to transmit light. <i>A hat with a diaphanous veil.</i>
directness	The quality of being plain and straightforward. <i>He was renowned for the clarity and directness of his sermons.</i>
forthrightness	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
friendliness	A feeling of liking for another person; enjoyment in their company. <i>I was overwhelmed by the friendliness of the people here.</i>
glass	Enclose with glass. <i>The inn has a long gallery now glassed in.</i>
glassy	(of sound) resembling the sharp noise made when glass is struck. <i>The glassy surface of the lake.</i>

guileless	Free of deceit. <i>His face once so open and guileless.</i>
<u>honest</u>	Without dissimulation; frank. <i>Good honest food with no gimmicks.</i>
<u>honesty</u>	A European plant with purple or white flowers and round, flat, translucent seed pods which are used for indoor flower arrangements. <i>They spoke with convincing honesty about their fears.</i>
integrity	An undivided or unbroken completeness or totality with nothing wanting. <i>Upholding territorial integrity and national sovereignty.</i>
limpid	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>Could see the sand on the bottom of the limpid pool.</i>
<u>lucid</u>	Showing or having the ability to think clearly, especially in intervals between periods of confusion or insanity. <i>A pellucid brook.</i>
<u>naive</u>	Of or created by one without formal training simple or naive in style. <i>A teenager's naive ignorance of life.</i>
<u>openness</u>	Characterized by an attitude of ready accessibility (especially about one's actions or purposes); without concealment; not secretive. <i>The openness of the prairies.</i>
pellucid	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i>His pellucid singing tone.</i>
perspicuity	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
perspicuous	Clearly expressed and easily understood; lucid. <i>A perspicuous argument.</i>
plain	Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness. <i>Everyone dined at a plain wooden table.</i>
<u>pure</u>	Being chromatically pure not diluted with white or grey or black. <i>Pure oxygen.</i>
simple	(botany) of leaf shapes; of leaves having no divisions or subdivisions. <i>A simple country schoolhouse.</i>
translucent	(of a substance) allowing light, but not detailed shapes, to pass through; semi-transparent. <i>Translucent amber.</i>
transparency	The quality of being clear and transparent. <i>The transparency of ice.</i>
vaporous	So thin as to transmit light. <i>The terminology is rather vaporous.</i>
