## Associations of "For transparent" (30 Words)

<b>accountability</b>	Responsibility to someone or for some activity. <i>Lack of <b>accountability</b> has corroded public respect for business and political leaders.</i>
<b>acrylic</b>	An acrylic textile fibre. <i>A red <b>acrylic</b> jumper.</i>
<b>candid</b>	(of a photograph of a person) taken informally, especially without the subject's knowledge. <i>A <b>candid</b> interview.</i>
<b>candor</b>	Ability to make judgments free from discrimination or dishonesty.
<b>clarity</b>	Free from obscurity and easy to understand; the comprehensibility of clear expression. <i>The <b>clarity</b> of the picture.</i>
<b>clear</b>	Make free from confusion or ambiguity make clear. <i>The following Saturday Mattie had a <b>clear</b> day.</i>
<b>crystalline</b>	Consisting of or containing or of the nature of crystals. <i>The cold <b>crystalline</b> water of melted snow.</i>
<b>diaphanous</b>	So thin as to transmit light. <i>A hat with a <b>diaphanous</b> veil.</i>
<b>directness</b>	The quality of being plain and straightforward. <i>He was renowned for the clarity and <b>directness</b> of his sermons.</i>
<b>forthrightness</b>	The quality of being honest and straightforward in attitude and speech.
<b>friendliness</b>	A feeling of liking for another person; enjoyment in their company. <i>I was overwhelmed by the <b>friendliness</b> of the people here.</i>
<b>glass</b>	Enclose with glass. <i>The inn has a long gallery now <b>glassed</b> in.</i>
<b>glassy</b>	(of sound) resembling the sharp noise made when glass is struck. <i>The <b>glassy</b> surface of the lake.</i>

<b>guileless</b>	Free of deceit. <i>His face once so open and <b>guileless</b>.</i>
<b>honest</b>	Without dissimulation; frank. <i>Good <b>honest</b> food with no gimmicks.</i>
<b>honesty</b>	A European plant with purple or white flowers and round, flat, translucent seed pods which are used for indoor flower arrangements. <i>They spoke with convincing <b>honesty</b> about their fears.</i>
<b>integrity</b>	An undivided or unbroken completeness or totality with nothing wanting. <i>Upholding territorial <b>integrity</b> and national sovereignty.</i>
<b>limpid</b>	(of language) transparently clear; easily understandable. <i>Could see the sand on the bottom of the <b>limpid</b> pool.</i>
<b>lucid</b>	Showing or having the ability to think clearly, especially in intervals between periods of confusion or insanity. <i>A <b>pellucid</b> brook.</i>
<b>naive</b>	Of or created by one without formal training simple or naive in style. <i>A teenager s <b>naive</b> ignorance of life.</i>
<b>openness</b>	Characterized by an attitude of ready accessibility (especially about one's actions or purposes); without concealment; not secretive. <i>The <b>openness</b> of the prairies.</i>
<b>pellucid</b>	Transparently clear; easily understandable- Robert Burton. <i>His <b>pellucid</b> singing tone.</i>
<b>perspicuity</b>	Clarity as a consequence of being perspicuous.
<b>perspicuous</b>	Clearly expressed and easily understood; lucid. <i>A <b>perspicuous</b> argument.</i>
<b>plain</b>	Express complaints discontent displeasure or unhappiness. <i>Everyone dined at a <b>plain</b> wooden table.</i>
<b>pure</b>	Being chromatically pure not diluted with white or grey or black. <i><b>Pure</b> oxygen.</i>
<b>simple</b>	(botany) of leaf shapes; of leaves having no divisions or subdivisions. <i>A <b>simple</b> country schoolhouse.</i>
<b>translucent</b>	(of a substance) allowing light, but not detailed shapes, to pass through; semi-transparent. <i><b>Translucent</b> amber.</i>
<b>transparency</b>	The quality of being clear and transparent. <i>The <b>transparency</b> of ice.</i>
<b>vaporous</b>	So thin as to transmit light. <i>The terminology is rather <b>vaporous</b>.</i>
