autocrat	An imperious person who insists on complete obedience from others. Like many <b>autocrat</b> s Franco found the exercise of absolute power addictive.
autocratic	Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power. An <b>autocratic</b> person.
<b>bloodthirsty</b>	Having or showing a desire to kill and maim. A <b>bloodthirsty</b> occult movie.
captor	A person that catches or confines another. <i>He managed to escape from his <b>captor</b>s two nights later.</i>
conqueror	A person who conquers a place or people; a vanquisher. A people ruled over by a foreign <b>conqueror</b> .
<u>cruelty</u>	Cruel behaviour or attitudes. <i>He has treated her with extreme <b>cruelty</b>.</i>
despot	A cruel and oppressive dictator.
despotism	A country or political system where the ruler holds absolute power. The ideology of enlightened <b>despotism</b> .
dictator	A ruler with total power over a country, typically one who has obtained control by force. My boss is a <b>dictator</b> who makes everyone work overtime.
dictatorship	A form of government in which the ruler is an absolute dictator (not restricted by a constitution or laws or opposition etc. <i>The effects of forty years of dictatorship</i> .
dominate	Be greater in significance than. The race was <b>dominate</b> d by the 1998 champion.
fascism	An authoritarian and nationalistic right-wing system of government and social organization. This is yet another example of health <b>fascism</b> in action.



fascist	Relating to or characteristic of fascism. If I were being a culinary <b>fascist</b> I would possibly moan about the overdone cooked tomatoes.
governor	The head of a state government. The <b>governor</b> of the Bank of England.
<u>invincible</u>	Too powerful to be defeated or overcome. An <b>invincible</b> army.
monocracy	A system of government by one person only.
<u>monopolize</u>	(of an organization or group) obtain exclusive possession or control of (a trade, commodity, or service. OPEC wants to <b>monopolize</b> oil.
oppression	The act of subjugating by cruelty. A region shattered by <b>oppression</b> and killing.
<u>oppressor</u>	A person or group that oppresses people. They overthrew their colonial <b>oppressor</b> s.
<u>regime</u>	A coordinated programme for the promotion or restoration of health a regimen. A tax <b>regime</b> .
<u>ruler</u>	A person exercising government or dominion.
ruthlessness	Feelings of extreme heartlessness. The real world <b>ruthlessness</b> of business.
satrap	A provincial governor in the ancient Persian empire.
<u>suppress</u>	Prevent the development, action, or expression of (a feeling, impulse, idea, etc.); restrain. <i>The rising was savagely</i> <b>suppress</b> ed.
tenure	Guaranteed permanent employment especially as a teacher or lecturer after a probationary period security of tenure. She was <b>tenure</b> d after she published her book.
totalitarianism	A system of government that is centralized and dictatorial and requires complete subservience to the state. <i>Democratic countries were fighting against totalitarianism</i> .
trespass	Commit a sin; violate a law of God or a moral law. Don t <b>trespass</b> on my land.
<u>tyranny</u>	Cruel and oppressive government or rule. The <b>tyranny</b> of the nine to five day.
viceroy	A ruler exercising authority in a colony on behalf of a sovereign.
