Associations of "For tyrant" (30 Words)

autocrat	An imperious person who insists on complete obedience from others. <i>Like many autocrats Franco found the exercise of absolute power addictive.</i>
autocratic	Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power. <i>An autocratic person.</i>
<u>bloodthirsty</u>	Having or showing a desire to kill and maim. <i>A bloodthirsty occult movie.</i>
captor	A person that catches or confines another. <i>He managed to escape from his captors two nights later.</i>
conqueror	A person who conquers a place or people; a vanquisher. <i>A people ruled over by a foreign conqueror.</i>
<u>cruelty</u>	Cruel behaviour or attitudes. <i>He has treated her with extreme cruelty.</i>
despot	A cruel and oppressive dictator.
despotism	A country or political system where the ruler holds absolute power. <i>The ideology of enlightened despotism.</i>
dictator	A ruler with total power over a country, typically one who has obtained control by force. <i>My boss is a dictator who makes everyone work overtime.</i>
dictatorship	A form of government in which the ruler is an absolute dictator (not restricted by a constitution or laws or opposition etc). <i>The effects of forty years of dictatorship.</i>
dominate	Be greater in significance than. <i>The race was dominated by the 1998 champion.</i>
fascism	An authoritarian and nationalistic right-wing system of government and social organization. <i>This is yet another example of health fascism in action.</i>

fascist	Relating to or characteristic of fascism. <i>If I were being a culinary fascist I would possibly moan about the overdone cooked tomatoes.</i>
governor	The head of a state government. <i>The governor of the Bank of England.</i>
<u>invincible</u>	Too powerful to be defeated or overcome. <i>An invincible army.</i>
monocracy	A system of government by one person only.
<u>monopolize</u>	(of an organization or group) obtain exclusive possession or control of (a trade, commodity, or service). <i>OPEC wants to monopolize oil.</i>
<u>oppression</u>	The act of subjugating by cruelty. <i>A region shattered by oppression and killing.</i>
<u>oppressor</u>	A person or group that oppresses people. <i>They overthrew their colonial oppressors.</i>
<u>regime</u>	A coordinated programme for the promotion or restoration of health a regimen. <i>A tax regime.</i>
<u>ruler</u>	A person exercising government or dominion.
ruthlessness	Feelings of extreme heartlessness. <i>The real world ruthlessness of business.</i>
satrap	A provincial governor in the ancient Persian empire.
<u>suppress</u>	Prevent the development, action, or expression of (a feeling, impulse, idea, etc.); restrain. <i>The rising was savagely suppressed.</i>
tenure	Guaranteed permanent employment especially as a teacher or lecturer after a probationary period security of tenure. <i>She was tenured after she published her book.</i>
totalitarianism	A system of government that is centralized and dictatorial and requires complete subservience to the state. <i>Democratic countries were fighting against totalitarianism.</i>
trespass	Commit a sin; violate a law of God or a moral law. <i>Don't trespass on my land.</i>
<u>tyranny</u>	Cruel and oppressive government or rule. <i>The tyranny of the nine to five day.</i>
viceroy	A ruler exercising authority in a colony on behalf of a sovereign.

victor

A combatant who is able to defeat rivals.
