## Associations of "For tyrant" (30 Words)

<b>autocrat</b>	An imperious person who insists on complete obedience from others. <i>Like many <b>autocrats</b> Franco found the exercise of absolute power addictive.</i>
<b>autocratic</b>	Offensively self-assured or given to exercising usually unwarranted power. <i>An <b>autocratic</b> person.</i>
<b><u>bloodthirsty</u></b>	Having or showing a desire to kill and maim. <i>A <b>bloodthirsty</b> occult movie.</i>
<b>captor</b>	A person that catches or confines another. <i>He managed to escape from his <b>captors</b> two nights later.</i>
<b>conqueror</b>	A person who conquers a place or people; a vanquisher. <i>A people ruled over by a foreign <b>conqueror</b>.</i>
<b><u>cruelty</u></b>	Cruel behaviour or attitudes. <i>He has treated her with extreme <b>cruelty</b>.</i>
<b>despot</b>	A cruel and oppressive dictator.
<b>despotism</b>	A country or political system where the ruler holds absolute power. <i>The ideology of enlightened <b>despotism</b>.</i>
<b>dictator</b>	A ruler with total power over a country, typically one who has obtained control by force. <i>My boss is a <b>dictator</b> who makes everyone work overtime.</i>
<b>dictatorship</b>	A form of government in which the ruler is an absolute dictator (not restricted by a constitution or laws or opposition etc). <i>The effects of forty years of <b>dictatorship</b>.</i>
<b>dominate</b>	Be greater in significance than. <i>The race was <b>dominated</b> by the 1998 champion.</i>
<b>fascism</b>	An authoritarian and nationalistic right-wing system of government and social organization. <i>This is yet another example of health <b>fascism</b> in action.</i>

<b>fascist</b>	Relating to or characteristic of fascism. <i>If I were being a culinary <b>fascist</b> I would possibly moan about the overdone cooked tomatoes.</i>
<b>governor</b>	The head of a state government. <i>The <b>governor</b> of the Bank of England.</i>
<b><u>invincible</u></b>	Too powerful to be defeated or overcome. <i>An <b>invincible</b> army.</i>
<b>monocracy</b>	A system of government by one person only.
<b><u>monopolize</u></b>	(of an organization or group) obtain exclusive possession or control of (a trade, commodity, or service). <i>OPEC wants to <b>monopolize</b> oil.</i>
<b><u>oppression</u></b>	The act of subjugating by cruelty. <i>A region shattered by <b>oppression</b> and killing.</i>
<b><u>oppressor</u></b>	A person or group that oppresses people. <i>They overthrew their colonial <b>oppressors</b>.</i>
<b><u>regime</u></b>	A coordinated programme for the promotion or restoration of health a regimen. <i>A tax <b>regime</b>.</i>
<b><u>ruler</u></b>	A person exercising government or dominion.
<b>ruthlessness</b>	Feelings of extreme heartlessness. <i>The real world <b>ruthlessness</b> of business.</i>
<b>satrap</b>	A provincial governor in the ancient Persian empire.
<b><u>suppress</u></b>	Prevent the development, action, or expression of (a feeling, impulse, idea, etc.); restrain. <i>The rising was savagely <b>suppressed</b>.</i>
<b>tenure</b>	Guaranteed permanent employment especially as a teacher or lecturer after a probationary period security of tenure. <i>She was <b>tenured</b> after she published her book.</i>
<b>totalitarianism</b>	A system of government that is centralized and dictatorial and requires complete subservience to the state. <i>Democratic countries were fighting against <b>totalitarianism</b>.</i>
<b>trespass</b>	Commit a sin; violate a law of God or a moral law. <i>Don't <b>trespass</b> on my land.</i>
<b><u>tyranny</u></b>	Cruel and oppressive government or rule. <i>The <b>tyranny</b> of the nine to five day.</i>
<b>viceroy</b>	A ruler exercising authority in a colony on behalf of a sovereign.

**victor**

A combatant who is able to defeat rivals.

*There were many dead on the field but no clear **victor**.*
