abrupt	Marked by sudden changes in subject and sharp transitions. <i>Came to an abrupt stop.</i>
abruptly	In a rude or curt manner. <i>The film ends rather abruptly.</i>
accidental	Not of prime or central importance. <i>Accidental poisoning.</i>
accidentally	Without advance planning. <i>His gun went off accidentally.</i>
amazingly	Very; extremely (usually expressing approval). <i>I genuinely thought Rachel sang amazingly.</i>
astonishing	So surprisingly impressive as to stun or overwhelm. <i>The dog was capable of astonishing tricks.</i>
awesome	Extremely good; excellent. <i>The awesome complexity of the universe.</i>
casually	In a relaxed and informal way. <i>I work casually as a staff nurse.</i>
coincidence	The quality of occupying the same position or area in space. <i>The interval determining the coincidence gate is adjustable.</i>
curiously	In a manner differing from the usual or expected. <i>The sentence is curiously worded.</i>
happen	Happen occur or be the case in the course of events or by chance. <i>The afternoon when the disturbance happened.</i>
inadvertently	Without intention; accidentally. <i>His name had been inadvertently omitted from the list.</i>
incident	Falling or striking of light rays on something. <i>The US regretted the incident.</i>

incidentally	In an incidental manner; as a chance occurrence. <i>Incidentally it was many months before the whole truth was discovered.</i>
occur	(of a thought or idea) come into the mind of. <i>Precious stones occur in a large area in Brazil.</i>
overhear	Hear (someone or something) without meaning to or without the knowledge of the speaker. <i>We overheard the conversation at the next table.</i>
startling	So remarkably different or sudden as to cause momentary shock or alarm. <i>Sydney s startling new Opera House.</i>
surprisingly	In an amazing manner; to everyone's surprise. <i>He rather surprisingly took up the cause.</i>
unanticipated	Not anticipated- H.W.Glidden. <i>Unanticipated and disconcerting lines of development.</i>
unconsciously	Without realizing or being aware of one's actions. <i>Ben smiled unconsciously when he heard her voice.</i>
unexpectedly	In a way that was not expected or regarded as likely. <i>Tourist chiefs reported unexpectedly high visitor numbers.</i>
unforeseen	Not anticipated. <i>Our insurance package enables you to protect yourself and your dependants against unforeseen circumstances.</i>
unheralded	Without warning or announcement- M.A.D.Howe. <i>He was unwilling to make an unheralded entrance.</i>
unintended	Not deliberate. <i>The unintended consequences of people s actions.</i>
unintentional	Not done on purpose. <i>The offense was unintentional.</i>
unintentionally	Not on purpose. <i>She hit him unintentionally.</i>
untoward	Not in keeping with accepted standards of what is right or proper in polite society. <i>Both tried to behave as if nothing untoward had happened.</i>
unusually	To a remarkable degree or extent. <i>She was unusually tall.</i>
unwitting	(of a person) not aware of the full facts. <i>His rudeness was unwitting.</i>
