**hussar** modelled on that of the Hungarian hussars now only in titles.

The Queen's Royal Irish **Hussar**s.



invariable (of a quantity) constant.

His **invariable** courtesy.

**jean** A coarse durable twill-weave cotton fabric.

**legging** A garment covering the leg (usually extending from the knee to the ankle.

A set of clothes worn together, especially for a particular occasion or

**outfit** purpose.

Warders **outfit**ted in special suits.

Underpants worn by women.

A **jean** jacket.

pants Corduroy pants.

Clothe formally especially in ecclesiastical robes.

**sandal** A shoe consisting of a sole fastened by straps to the foot.

undergarment A garment worn under other garments.

**underwear** Undergarment worn next to the skin and under the outer garments.
