Associations of "For uniform" (30 Words)

apparel	Provide with clothes or put clothes on. <i>They were dressed in bright apparel.</i>
<u>boot</u>	Kick give a boot to. <i>When I booted the computer I heard a extremely loud rattle.</i>
brogan	A coarse stout leather shoe reaching to the ankle.
brogue	A thick and heavy shoe.
clad	Covered with cladding. <i>Leather clad boys.</i>
clothed	Wearing or provided with clothing; sometimes used in combination- Bible. <i>A partially clothed body.</i>
clothes	Bedclothes. <i>Baby clothes.</i>
clothing	Clothes collectively. <i>Bring warm clothing and waterproofs.</i>
corset	Dress with a corset.
<u>dress</u>	Clean treat or apply a dressing to a wound. <i>After you dress a dry fly be sure to remove any oil before you make your next cast.</i>
<u>dressed</u>	Dressed in fancy or formal clothing. <i>Dressed crab.</i>
footwear	Clothing worn on a person’s feet.
gown	Put on a surgical gown. <i>The lab is supposed to be sterile so you have to gown up.</i>
hosiery	Stockings, socks, and tights collectively.
hussar	A soldier in a light cavalry regiment which had adopted a dress uniform modelled on that of the Hungarian hussars now only in titles. <i>The Queen's Royal Irish Hussars.</i>

invariable	(of a quantity) constant. <i>His invariable courtesy.</i>
jean	A coarse durable twill-weave cotton fabric. <i>A jean jacket.</i>
legging	A garment covering the leg (usually extending from the knee to the ankle).
outfit	A set of clothes worn together, especially for a particular occasion or purpose. <i>Warders outfitted in special suits.</i>
pants	Underpants worn by women. <i>Corduroy pants.</i>
robe	Clothe formally especially in ecclesiastical robes. <i>He was dressed in his archbishop s robes after some function.</i>
sandal	A shoe consisting of a sole fastened by straps to the foot. <i>They were dressed in open toed sandals.</i>
shoes	A particular situation.
skimpy	Providing or consisting of less than is needed; meagre. <i>A skimpy allowance.</i>
swimsuit	A woman's one-piece swimming costume.
undergarment	A garment worn under other garments.
underwear	Undergarment worn next to the skin and under the outer garments.
uniformed	Wearing a uniform. <i>Uniformed police officers.</i>
vestment	Gown (especially ceremonial garments) worn by the clergy. <i>A priest in green vestments came and preached a long sermon.</i>
wear	The wearing of something or the state of being worn as clothing. <i>He always wears a smile.</i>
