<u>counterproductive</u>	Having the opposite of the desired effect. Child experts fear the Executive s plans may prove counterproductive.
execrable	Of very poor quality or condition. <i>Execrable</i> crimes.
fruitless	Failing to achieve the desired results; unproductive or useless. A banana leaf from a fruitless palm.
<u>futile</u>	Incapable of producing any useful result; pointless. <i>Futile</i> years after her artistic peak.
futilely	In a futile and unproductive manner.
<u>garbage</u>	A worthless message. <i>Garbage</i> littered the estate.
gratuitous	Without cause. <i>Gratuitous</i> violence.
ineffective	Not producing any significant or desired effect. An ineffective teacher.
<u>ineffectual</u>	Producing no result or effect. An ineffectual ruler.
<u>inefficiency</u>	Unskillfulness resulting from a lack of efficiency. The idea is to eliminate inefficiency creating a seamless manufacturing process.
infertile	Incapable of reproducing. <i>Infertile</i> couples are offered specialist advice.



<u>invalid</u>	Disable (someone) by injury or illness. <i>Her invalid husband.</i>
misfire	A failure to hit (or meet or find etc. <i>The guns misfired</i> .
nihilism	The delusion that things (or everything, including the self) do not exist; a sense that everything is unreal.
nugatory	Of no real value. A nugatory law.
<u>obsolete</u>	Cause a product or idea to become obsolete by replacing it with something new. <i>The disposal of old and obsolete machinery.</i>
paltry	Petty; trivial. Naval glory struck him as paltry .
powerless	Without ability, influence, or power. Troops were powerless to stop last night s shooting.
superfluous	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. Delete superfluous or unnecessary words.
<u>trivia</u>	Something of small importance. We fill our days with meaningless trivia .
<u>trivial</u>	Concerned with trivialities. A trivial mind.
unavailing	Achieving little or nothing; ineffective. An unavailing attempt.
<u>unproductive</u>	Not producing desired results. Unproductive land must be reforested.
vain	Having no likelihood of fulfilment; empty. A vain boast.
valueless	Having no value; worthless. Cherished but valueless heirlooms.
void	(of speech or action) ineffectual; useless. Null and void .
wasted	(of a person or a part of the body) weak or emaciated. <i>Advice is wasted words.</i>
worthless	Morally reprehensible. A worthless idler.
