<b>bootless</b>	Unproductive of success. <i>Remonstrating with him seems ever to have been a <b>bootless</b> task.</i>
<b>breakage</b>	The quantity broken. <i>The total <b>breakage</b> was huge.</i>
<b>counterproductive</b>	Having the opposite of the desired effect. <i>Child experts fear the Executive s plans may prove <b>counterproductive</b>.</i>
<b>execrable</b>	Of very poor quality or condition. <i><b>Execrable</b> crimes.</i>
<b>fruitless</b>	Failing to achieve the desired results; unproductive or useless. <i>A banana leaf from a <b>fruitless</b> palm.</i>
<b>futile</b>	Incapable of producing any useful result; pointless. <i><b>Futile</b> years after her artistic peak.</i>
<b>futilely</b>	In a futile and unproductive manner.
<b>garbage</b>	A worthless message. <i><b>Garbage</b> littered the estate.</i>
<b>gratuitous</b>	Without cause. <i><b>Gratuitous</b> violence.</i>
<b>ineffective</b>	Not producing any significant or desired effect. <i>An <b>ineffective</b> teacher.</i>
<b>ineffectual</b>	Producing no result or effect. <i>An <b>ineffectual</b> ruler.</i>
<b>inefficiency</b>	Unskillfulness resulting from a lack of efficiency. <i>The idea is to eliminate <b>inefficiency</b> creating a seamless manufacturing process.</i>
<b>infertile</b>	Incapable of reproducing. <i><b>Infertile</b> couples are offered specialist advice.</i>

<b><u>invalid</u></b>	Disable (someone) by injury or illness. <i>Her <b>invalid</b> husband.</i>
<b>misfire</b>	A failure to hit (or meet or find etc). <i>The guns <b>misfired</b>.</i>
<b>nihilism</b>	The delusion that things (or everything, including the self) do not exist; a sense that everything is unreal.
<b>nugatory</b>	Of no real value. <i>A <b>nugatory</b> law.</i>
<b><u>obsolete</u></b>	Cause a product or idea to become obsolete by replacing it with something new. <i>The disposal of old and <b>obsolete</b> machinery.</i>
<b>paltry</b>	Petty; trivial. <i>Naval glory struck him as <b>paltry</b>.</i>
<b>powerless</b>	Without ability, influence, or power. <i>Troops were <b>powerless</b> to stop last night's shooting.</i>
<b>superfluous</b>	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. <i>Delete <b>superfluous</b> or unnecessary words.</i>
<b><u>trivia</u></b>	Something of small importance. <i>We fill our days with meaningless <b>trivia</b>.</i>
<b><u>trivial</u></b>	Concerned with trivialities. <i>A <b>trivial</b> mind.</i>
<b>unavailing</b>	Achieving little or nothing; ineffective. <i>An <b>unavailing</b> attempt.</i>
<b><u>unproductive</u></b>	Not producing desired results. <i><b>Unproductive</b> land must be reforested.</i>
<b>vain</b>	Having no likelihood of fulfilment; empty. <i>A <b>vain</b> boast.</i>
<b>valueless</b>	Having no value; worthless. <i>Cherished but <b>valueless</b> heirlooms.</i>
<b><u>void</u></b>	(of speech or action) ineffectual; useless. <i>Null and <b>void</b>.</i>
<b><u>wasted</u></b>	(of a person or a part of the body) weak or emaciated. <i>Advice is <b>wasted</b> words.</i>
<b>worthless</b>	Morally reprehensible. <i>A <b>worthless</b> idler.</i>
