bootless	Unproductive of success. <i>Remonstrating with him seems ever to have been a bootless task.</i>
breakage	The quantity broken. <i>The total breakage was huge.</i>
counterproductive	Having the opposite of the desired effect. <i>Child experts fear the Executive s plans may prove counterproductive.</i>
execrable	Of very poor quality or condition. <i>Execrable crimes.</i>
fruitless	Failing to achieve the desired results; unproductive or useless. <i>A banana leaf from a fruitless palm.</i>
futile	Incapable of producing any useful result; pointless. <i>Futile years after her artistic peak.</i>
futilely	In a futile and unproductive manner.
garbage	A worthless message. <i>Garbage littered the estate.</i>
gratuitous	Without cause. <i>Gratuitous violence.</i>
ineffective	Not producing any significant or desired effect. <i>An ineffective teacher.</i>
ineffectual	Producing no result or effect. <i>An ineffectual ruler.</i>
inefficiency	Unskillfulness resulting from a lack of efficiency. <i>The idea is to eliminate inefficiency creating a seamless manufacturing process.</i>
infertile	Incapable of reproducing. <i>Infertile couples are offered specialist advice.</i>

<u>invalid</u>	Disable (someone) by injury or illness. <i>Her invalid husband.</i>
misfire	A failure to hit (or meet or find etc). <i>The guns misfired.</i>
nihilism	The delusion that things (or everything, including the self) do not exist; a sense that everything is unreal.
nugatory	Of no real value. <i>A nugatory law.</i>
<u>obsolete</u>	Cause a product or idea to become obsolete by replacing it with something new. <i>The disposal of old and obsolete machinery.</i>
paltry	Petty; trivial. <i>Naval glory struck him as paltry.</i>
powerless	Without ability, influence, or power. <i>Troops were powerless to stop last night's shooting.</i>
superfluous	Serving no useful purpose; having no excuse for being. <i>Delete superfluous or unnecessary words.</i>
<u>trivia</u>	Something of small importance. <i>We fill our days with meaningless trivia.</i>
<u>trivial</u>	Concerned with trivialities. <i>A trivial mind.</i>
unavailing	Achieving little or nothing; ineffective. <i>An unavailing attempt.</i>
<u>unproductive</u>	Not producing desired results. <i>Unproductive land must be reforested.</i>
vain	Having no likelihood of fulfilment; empty. <i>A vain boast.</i>
valueless	Having no value; worthless. <i>Cherished but valueless heirlooms.</i>
<u>void</u>	(of speech or action) ineffectual; useless. <i>Null and void.</i>
<u>wasted</u>	(of a person or a part of the body) weak or emaciated. <i>Advice is wasted words.</i>
worthless	Morally reprehensible. <i>A worthless idler.</i>
