afflatus	A divine creative impulse or inspiration. <i>Divine afflatus.</i>
author	The writings produced by a particular author. The concept has been author ed largely by insurance companies.
<u>bard</u>	Shakespeare. Our national bard Robert Burns.
dictation	Words that are dictated. Passages for dictation .
essay	An attempt or effort. The infant had essay ed a few wobbly steps.
indite	Produce a literary work. <i>He indites the wondrous tale of Our Lord</i> .
interpolation	Calculation of the value of a function between the values already known. <i>The interpolation formula.</i>
<u>journal</u>	Write in a journal or diary. Medical journal s.
manuscript	A book, document, or piece of music written by hand rather than typed or printed. <i>Early Gothic manuscripts.</i>
minstrel	Celebrate by singing in the style of minstrels. They listened to the minstrel s singing songs of knightly prowess.
notebook	A book with blank pages for recording notes or memoranda. <i>He copied the number into his notebook.</i>
<u>ode</u>	A lyric poem, typically one in the form of an address to a particular subject, written in varied or irregular metre.



pen	An electronic device like a pen used in conjunction with a writing surface to enter commands or data into a computer. She was forced to support herself by the pen .	
<u>poem</u>	A composition written in metrical feet forming rhythmical lines. A poem in terza rima.	
poet	A writer of poems the term is usually reserved for writers of good poetry. <i>He is more poet than academic because of his gift for language.</i>	
<u>poetic</u>	Having an imaginative or sensitively emotional style of expression. <i>Turner s vision of the rainbow was poetic.</i>	
poetics	The art of writing poetry. Both poetics and rhetoric make use of narrative structure.	
<u>prose</u>	A passage of prose for translation into a foreign language. A prose passage.	
quatrain	A stanza of four lines.	
<u>script</u>	Write a script for a play film or broadcast. It was perfectly script ed and beautifully acted.	
shorthand	A method of rapid writing by means of abbreviations and symbols used especially for taking dictation The major systems of shorthand currently in use are those devised in 1837 by Sir Isaac Pitman and in the US in 1888 by John R Gregg 1867 1948. <i>Poetry for him is simply a shorthand for literature that has aesthetic value.</i>	
sonnet	Praise in a sonnet. And in delightful Tones sit sonnet ing.	
<u>spell</u>	Orally recite the letters of or give the spelling of. <i>The letters spell the word how.</i>	
stenographer	A person whose job is to transcribe speech in shorthand. A court stenographer .	
<u>text</u>	Send someone a text message. They handed out the printed text of the mayor s speech.	
<u>transcribe</u>	Convert the genetic information in (a strand of DNA) into a strand of RNA, especially messenger RNA. <i>The court was adjourned so that they could transcribe their notes.</i>	
transcription	The organic process whereby the DNA sequence in a gene is copied into mRNA; the process whereby a base sequence of messenger RNA is synthesized on a template of complementary DNA. The funding covers transcription of nearly illegible photocopies.	
verse	Speak in or compose verse versify. He began to verse extemporaneously in her ear.	



<u>writer</u>	A clerk, especially in the navy or in government offices. <i>A CD writer</i> .
writing	The activity or skill of writing. The writing is straightforward and accessible.
