## Associations of "For write" (30 Words)

<b>afflatus</b>	A divine creative impulse or inspiration. <i>Divine <b>afflatus</b>.</i>
<b>author</b>	The writings produced by a particular author. <i>The concept has been <b>authored</b> largely by insurance companies.</i>
<b>bard</b>	Shakespeare. <i>Our national <b>bard</b> Robert Burns.</i>
<b>dictation</b>	Words that are dictated. <i>Passages for <b>dictation</b>.</i>
<b>essay</b>	An attempt or effort. <i>The infant had <b>essayed</b> a few wobbly steps.</i>
<b>indite</b>	Produce a literary work. <i>He <b>indites</b> the wondrous tale of Our Lord.</i>
<b>interpolation</b>	Calculation of the value of a function between the values already known. <i>The <b>interpolation</b> formula.</i>
<b>journal</b>	Write in a journal or diary. <i>Medical <b>journals</b>.</i>
<b>manuscript</b>	A book, document, or piece of music written by hand rather than typed or printed. <i>Early Gothic <b>manuscripts</b>.</i>
<b>minstrel</b>	Celebrate by singing in the style of minstrels. <i>They listened to the <b>minstrels</b> singing songs of knightly prowess.</i>
<b>notebook</b>	A book with blank pages for recording notes or memoranda. <i>He copied the number into his <b>notebook</b>.</i>
<b>ode</b>	A lyric poem, typically one in the form of an address to a particular subject, written in varied or irregular metre.

<b>pen</b>	An electronic device like a pen used in conjunction with a writing surface to enter commands or data into a computer. <i>She was forced to support herself by the <b>pen</b>.</i>
<b>poem</b>	A composition written in metrical feet forming rhythmical lines. <i>A <b>poem</b> in terza rima.</i>
<b>poet</b>	A writer of poems the term is usually reserved for writers of good poetry. <i>He is more <b>poet</b> than academic because of his gift for language.</i>
<b>poetic</b>	Having an imaginative or sensitively emotional style of expression. <i>Turner's vision of the rainbow was <b>poetic</b>.</i>
<b>poetics</b>	The art of writing poetry. <i>Both <b>poetics</b> and rhetoric make use of narrative structure.</i>
<b>prose</b>	A passage of prose for translation into a foreign language. <i>A <b>prose</b> passage.</i>
<b>quatrain</b>	A stanza of four lines.
<b>script</b>	Write a script for a play film or broadcast. <i>It was perfectly <b>scripted</b> and beautifully acted.</i>
<b>shorthand</b>	A method of rapid writing by means of abbreviations and symbols used especially for taking dictation The major systems of shorthand currently in use are those devised in 1837 by Sir Isaac Pitman and in the US in 1888 by John R Gregg 1867 1948. <i>Poetry for him is simply a <b>shorthand</b> for literature that has aesthetic value.</i>
<b>sonnet</b>	Praise in a sonnet. <i>And in delightful Tones sit <b>sonneting</b>.</i>
<b>spell</b>	Orally recite the letters of or give the spelling of. <i>The letters <b>spell</b> the word how.</i>
<b>stenographer</b>	A person whose job is to transcribe speech in shorthand. <i>A court <b>stenographer</b>.</i>
<b>text</b>	Send someone a text message. <i>They handed out the printed <b>text</b> of the mayor's speech.</i>
<b>transcribe</b>	Convert the genetic information in (a strand of DNA) into a strand of RNA, especially messenger RNA. <i>The court was adjourned so that they could <b>transcribe</b> their notes.</i>
<b>transcription</b>	The organic process whereby the DNA sequence in a gene is copied into mRNA; the process whereby a base sequence of messenger RNA is synthesized on a template of complementary DNA. <i>The funding covers <b>transcription</b> of nearly illegible photocopies.</i>
<b>verse</b>	Speak in or compose verse versify. <i>He began to <b>verse</b> extemporaneously in her ear.</i>

The activity or skill of writing.
