Plural

I forecast

We forecast

You forecast

You forecast

He/She/It forecasts

They forecast

Forecast in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I am forecasting

We are forecasting

You are forecasting

You are forecasting

He/She/It is forecasting

They are forecasting

Forecast in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I have forecast or forecasted

We have forecast or forecasted

You have forecast or forecasted

You have forecast or forecasted

He/She/It has forecast or forecasted

They have forecast or forecasted

Forecast in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I have been forecasting

We have been forecasting

You have been forecasting

You have been forecasting

He/She/It has been forecasting

They have been forecasting

Forecast in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I forecast or forecasted

We forecast or forecasted

You forecast or forecasted

You forecast or forecasted

He/She/It forecast or forecasted

They forecast or forecasted

Forecast in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **was forecasting** We **were forecasting**
You **were forecasting** You **were forecasting**
He/She/It **was forecasting** They **were forecasting**

Forecast in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **had forecast or forecasted** We **had forecast or forecasted**
You **had forecast or forecasted** You **had forecast or forecasted**
He/She/It **had forecast or forecasted** They **had forecast or forecasted**

Forecast in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **had been forecasting** We **had been forecasting**
You **had been forecasting** You **had been forecasting**
He/She/It **had been forecasting** They **had been forecasting**

Forecast in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **will forecast** We **will forecast**
You **will forecast** You **will forecast**
He/She/It **will forecast** They **will forecast**

Forecast in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **will be forecasting** We **will be forecasting**
You **will be forecasting** You **will be forecasting**
He/She/It **will be forecasting** They **will be forecasting**

Forecast in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have forecast or forecasted

We will have forecast or forecasted

You will have forecast or forecasted

You will have forecast or forecasted

He/She/It will have forecast or forecasted **They will have forecast or forecasted**

Forecast in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have been forecasting

We will have been forecasting

You will have been forecasting

You will have been forecasting

He/She/It will have been forecasting **They will have been forecasting**
