Present Tense	<b>foreordinate / foreordinates</b>
Past Tense	<b>foreordinated</b>
Present Participle	<b>foreordinating</b>
Past Participle	<b>foreordinated</b>

## Conjugate Foreordinate

**Foreordinate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **foreordinate**                      We **foreordinate**  
You **foreordinate**                You **foreordinate**  
He/She/It **foreordinates**    They **foreordinate**

**Foreordinate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am foreordinating**            We **are foreordinating**  
You **are foreordinating**        You **are foreordinating**  
He/She/It **is foreordinating**    They **are foreordinating**

**Foreordinate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have foreordinated**            We **have foreordinated**  
You **have foreordinated**        You **have foreordinated**  
He/She/It **has foreordinated**    They **have foreordinated**

**Foreordinate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been foreordinating**        We **have been foreordinating**  
You **have been foreordinating**      You **have been foreordinating**  
He/She/It **has been foreordinating**    They **have been foreordinating**

**Foreordinate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **foreordinated**                      We **foreordinated**  
You **foreordinated**                You **foreordinated**  
He/She/It **foreordinated**        They **foreordinated**

**Foreordinate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was foreordinating**      We **were foreordinating**  
You **were foreordinating**      You **were foreordinating**  
He/She/It **was foreordinating**      They **were foreordinating**

**Foreordinate in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had foreordinated**      We **had foreordinated**  
You **had foreordinated**      You **had foreordinated**  
He/She/It **had foreordinated**      They **had foreordinated**

**Foreordinate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

I **had been foreordinating**      We **had been foreordinating**  
You **had been foreordinating**      You **had been foreordinating**  
He/She/It **had been foreordinating**      They **had been foreordinating**

**Foreordinate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will foreordinate**      We **will foreordinate**  
You **will foreordinate**      You **will foreordinate**  
He/She/It **will foreordinate**      They **will foreordinate**

**Foreordinate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be foreordinating**      We **will be foreordinating**  
You **will be foreordinating**      You **will be foreordinating**  
He/She/It **will be foreordinating**      They **will be foreordinating**

**Foreordinate in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have foreordained**

**We will have foreordained**

**You will have foreordained**

**You will have foreordained**

**He/She/It will have foreordained**

**They will have foreordained**

**I will have been foreordinating**

**We will have been foreordinating**

**You will have been foreordinating**

**You will have been foreordinating**

**He/She/It will have been foreordinating**
