The Forms of Forget

Infinitive	to forget
Present Tense	forget / forgets
Past Tense	forgot or (archaic) forgat
Present Participle	forgetting
Past Participle	forgotten or (rarely) forgot

Conjugate Forget

Forget in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **forget** We **forget**
You **forget** You **forget**
He/She/It **forgets** They **forget**

Forget in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am forgetting** We **are forgetting**
You **are forgetting** You **are forgetting**
He/She/It **is forgetting** They **are forgetting**

Forget in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have forgotten or (rarely) forgot** We **have forgotten or (rarely) forgot**
You **have forgotten or (rarely) forgot** You **have forgotten or (rarely) forgot**
He/She/It **has forgotten or (rarely) forgot** They **have forgotten or (rarely) forgot**

Forget in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have been forgetting** We **have been forgetting**
You **have been forgetting** You **have been forgetting**
He/She/It **has been forgetting** They **have been forgetting**

Forget in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **forgot or (archaic) forgat** We **forgot or (archaic) forgat**
You **forgot or (archaic) forgat** You **forgot or (archaic) forgat**
He/She/It **forgot or (archaic) forgat** They **forgot or (archaic) forgat**

Forget in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was forgetting We were forgetting
You were forgetting You were forgetting
He/She/It was forgetting They were forgetting

Forget in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had forgotten or (rarely) forgot We had forgotten or (rarely) forgot
You had forgotten or (rarely) forgot You had forgotten or (rarely) forgot
He/She/It had forgotten or (rarely) forgot They had forgotten or (rarely) forgot

Forget in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been forgetting We had been forgetting
You had been forgetting You had been forgetting
He/She/It had been forgetting They had been forgetting

Forget in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will forget We will forget
You will forget You will forget
He/She/It will forget They will forget

Forget in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be forgetting We will be forgetting
You will be forgetting You will be forgetting
He/She/It will be forgetting They will be forgetting

Forget in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

I will have forgotten or (rarely) forgot

You will have forgotten or (rarely) forgot

He/She/It will have forgotten or (rarely) forgot

Plural

We will have forgotten or (rarely) forgot

You will have forgotten or (rarely) forgot

They will have forgotten or (rarely) forgot

Forget in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I will have been forgetting

You will have been forgetting

He/She/It will have been forgetting

Plural

We will have been forgetting

You will have been forgetting

They will have been forgetting
