<b>celebration</b>	The action of celebrating an important day or event. <i>The <b>celebration</b> of marriage.</i>
<b>ceremonial</b>	A formal event performed on a special occasion. <i>The Great Court was built to accommodate the grandest of <b>ceremonials</b>.</i>

<b>ceremony</b>	A formal religious or public occasion, especially one celebrating a particular event, achievement, or anniversary. <i>The <b>ceremony</b> of smelling the cork and tasting the wine.</i>
<b>conceptualisation</b>	Inventing or contriving an idea or explanation and formulating it mentally.
<u>conceptualization</u>	Inventing or contriving an idea or explanation and formulating it mentally. <i>Our experience is beyond any <b>conceptualization</b>.</i>
<b>contrivance</b>	An artificial or unnatural or obviously contrived arrangement of details or parts etc. <i>An assortment of electronic equipment and mechanical <b>contrivances</b>.</i>
<b>creation</b>	An artifact that has been brought into existence by someone. <i>She treats fictional <b>creations</b> as if they were real people.</i>
<b>design</b>	A decorative or artistic work. <i>The awkward <b>design</b> of the keyboard made operation difficult.</i>
<b>development</b>	A district that has been developed to serve some purpose. <i>Such land is practical for small park <b>developments</b>.</i>
<b>devising</b>	The act that results in something coming to be. <i>The <b>devising</b> of plans.</i>
<b>expression</b>	Expression without words. <i>The <b>expression</b> for the circumference of a circle is <math>2r</math>.</i>
<b>innovation</b>	A new method, idea, product, etc. <i>Technological <b>innovations</b> designed to save energy.</i>
<u>observance</u>	A rule to be followed by a religious order. <i>The tramp gave them no <b>observance</b>.</i>
<b>office</b>	A service conducted daily as part of the office. <i>He rented an <b>office</b> in the new building.</i>
<b>ordinance</b>	An authoritative rule. <i>His strict observance of religious <b>ordinances</b> was no doubt quickened by the remorse he felt.</i>
<u>origination</u>	The act of starting something for the first time; introducing something new. <i>Mortgage loan <b>originations</b> were up 15 per cent.</i>
<b>preparation</b>	A substance that is specially made up, especially a medicine or food. <i>The <b>preparation</b> of a draft contract.</i>
<b>rite</b>	A social custom, practice, or conventional act. <i>The Byzantine <b>rite</b>.</i>

<b><u>ritual</u></b>	A prescribed order for performing a ritual ceremony especially one characteristic of a particular religion or Church. <i>The role of <b>ritual</b> in religion.</i>
<b>sacrament</b>	A formal religious ceremony conferring a specific grace on those who receive it; the two Protestant ceremonies are baptism and the Lord's Supper; in the Roman Catholic Church and the Eastern Orthodox Church there are seven traditional r. <i>He heard Mass and received the <b>sacrament</b>.</i>
<b>service</b>	A company or agency that performs a public service subject to government regulation. <i>The pitifully low wages gained from domestic <b>service</b>.</i>
<b>solemnity</b>	A solemn and dignified feeling. <i>His ashes were laid to rest with great <b>solemnity</b>.</i>
<b><u>worship</u></b>	The activity of worshipping. <i>The <b>worship</b> of celebrity and wealth.</i>
