Infinitive	<b>to forslip</b>
Present Tense	<b>forslip / forslips</b>
Past Tense	<b>forslipped or forslipt</b>
Present Participle	<b>forslipping</b>
Past Participle	<b>forslipped or forslipt</b>

## Conjugate Forslip

**Forslip in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **forslip**

We **forslip**

You **forslip**

You **forslip**

He/She/It **forslips** They **forslip**

### **Forslip in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am forslipping**

We **are forslipping**

You **are forslipping**

You **are forslipping**

He/She/It **is forslipping** They **are forslipping**

### **Forslip in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have forslipped or forslipt**

We **have forslipped or forslipt**

You **have forslipped or forslipt**

You **have forslipped or forslipt**

He/She/It **has forslipped or forslipt** They **have forslipped or forslipt**

### **Forslip in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been forslipping**

We **have been forslipping**

You **have been forslipping**

You **have been forslipping**

He/She/It **has been forslipping** They **have been forslipping**

### **Forslip in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **forslipped or forslipt**

We **forslipped or forslipt**

You **forslipped or forslipt**

You **forslipped or forslipt**

He/She/It **forslipped or forslipt** They **forslipped or forslipt**

### **Forslip in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was forslipping      We were forslipping  
You were forslipping      You were forslipping  
He/She/It was forslipping      They were forslipping

**Forslip in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had forslipped or forslipt      We had forslipped or forslipt  
You had forslipped or forslipt      You had forslipped or forslipt  
He/She/It had forslipped or forslipt      They had forslipped or forslipt

**Forslip in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been forslipping      We had been forslipping  
You had been forslipping      You had been forslipping  
He/She/It had been forslipping      They had been forslipping

**Forslip in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will forslip      We will forslip  
You will forslip      You will forslip  
He/She/It will forslip      They will forslip

**Forslip in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be forslipping      We will be forslipping  
You will be forslipping      You will be forslipping  
He/She/It will be forslipping      They will be forslipping

**Forslip in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have forslipped or forslipt**

**We will have forslipped or forslipt**

**You will have forslipped or forslipt**

**You will have forslipped or forslipt**

**He/She/It will have forslipped or forslipt** **They will have forslipped or forslipt**

**Forslip in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been forslipping**

**We will have been forslipping**

**You will have been forslipping**

**You will have been forslipping**

**He/She/It will have been forslipping** **They will have been forslipping**
