## Associations of "Fought" (30 Words)

<b>altercation</b>	A noisy argument or disagreement, especially in public. <i>I had an <b>altercation</b> with the ticket collector.</i>
<b>argue</b>	Present reasons and arguments. <i>I wasn't going to <b>argue</b> with a gun.</i>
<a href="#">argument</a>	An independent variable associated with a function or proposition and determining its value For example in the expression $y = F(x)$ the arguments of the function $F$ are $x$ and $x$ and the value is $y$ . <i>The <b>argument</b> over foreign aid goes on and on.</i>
<b>bellicose</b>	Having or showing a ready disposition to fight. <i>A mood of <b>bellicose</b> jingoism.</i>
<b>bicker</b>	Argue over petty things. <i>The restless wheels whose flashing spokes <b>bicker</b> and burn.</i>
<b>brawl</b>	A rough or noisy fight or quarrel. <i>He'd got into a drunken <b>brawl</b> in a bar.</i>
<b>combative</b>	Inclined or showing an inclination to dispute or disagree, even to engage in law suits. <i>A <b>combative</b> impulse.</i>
<b>conflict</b>	Be in conflict. <i>Parents and children's interests sometimes <b>conflict</b>.</i>
<a href="#">confrontational</a>	Tending to deal with situations in an aggressive way; hostile or argumentative. <i>He distanced himself from the <b>confrontational</b> approach adopted by his predecessor.</i>
<a href="#">contend</a>	To make the subject of dispute, contention, or litigation. <i>He <b>contends</b> that the judge was wrong.</i>
<a href="#">contention</a>	The act of competing as for profit or a prize. <i>The captured territory was the main area of <b>contention</b> between the two countries.</i>

<b><u>contentious</u></b>	Inclined or showing an inclination to dispute or disagree, even to engage in law suits. <i>The socio economic plan had been the subject of <b>contentious</b> debate.</i>
<b><u>controversy</u></b>	A contentious speech act; a dispute where there is strong disagreement. <i>The design of the building has caused <b>controversy</b>.</i>
<b>counterattack</b>	Make a counterattack.
<b><u>disagree</u></b>	(of statements or accounts) be inconsistent or fail to correspond. <i>No one was willing to <b>disagree</b> with him.</i>
<b><u>disagreement</u></b>	Lack of consensus or approval. <i>There was some <b>disagreement</b> about the details.</i>
<b><u>discord</u></b>	(of things) be different. <i>The party's views were apt to <b>discord</b> with those of the leading members of the government.</i>
<b>disputatious</b>	Fond of having heated arguments. <i>A <b>disputatious</b> lawyer.</i>
<b>dispute</b>	Take exception to. <i>An industrial <b>dispute</b>.</i>
<b>dissension</b>	Disagreement among those expected to cooperate. <i>These issues caused bitter <b>dissension</b> in the party.</i>
<b>factious</b>	Dissenting (especially dissenting with the majority opinion). <i>A <b>factious</b> country.</i>
<b><u>quarrel</u></b>	Have a heated argument or disagreement. <i>We <b>quarreled</b> over the question as to who discovered America.</i>
<b>quarrelsome</b>	Given to quarreling. <i><b>Quarrelsome</b> when drinking.</i>
<b><u>rivalry</u></b>	Competition for the same objective or for superiority in the same field. <i>There always has been intense <b>rivalry</b> between the clubs.</i>
<b>strife</b>	Angry or bitter disagreement over fundamental issues; conflict. <i>Decades of civil <b>strife</b>.</i>
<b>struggle</b>	A forceful or violent effort to get free of restraint or resist attack. <i>The centre is the result of the scientists <b>struggle</b> to realize their dream.</i>
<b>tussle</b>	Make messy or untidy. <i>There was a <b>tussle</b> for the ball.</i>
<b><u>wrangle</u></b>	An instance of intense argument (as in bargaining). <i><b>Wrangle</b> horses.</i>
<b>wrangling</b>	An instance of intense argument (as in bargaining). <i>Weeks of political <b>wrangling</b>.</i>
