Any property detected by the olfactory system.
*The **aroma** of officialdom.*

balm

The resinous substance yielded by a balm.
*The murmur of the water can provide **balm** for troubled spirits.*

balminess

The quality of weather that is deliciously mild and soothing.
*The day's heat faded into **balminess**.*

[bouquet](#)

An expression of approval; a compliment.
*The aperitif has a faint **bouquet** of almonds.*

eau de toilette A perfumed liquid lighter than cologne.

fragrancy

Fragrance.

[nose](#)

A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft.
*He pushed his glasses higher on to the bridge of his **nose**.*

odour	A lingering quality or impression attaching to something. <i>An odour of suspicion.</i>
<u>perfume</u>	A distinctive odor that is pleasant. <i>I caught a whiff of her fresh lemony perfume.</i>
redolence	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
<u>scent</u>	Any property detected by the olfactory system. <i>The scent of freshly cut hay.</i>
sweet smell	A food rich in sugar.
<u>sweetness</u>	Used as an affectionate form of address, though often ironically. <i>I ve just got to go sweetness.</i>
toilet water	Misfortune resulting in lost effort or money.

ambergris	A waxy substance that originates as a secretion in the intestines of the sperm whale, found floating in tropical seas and used in perfume manufacture.
ambrosial	Extremely pleasing to the taste; sweet and fragrant. <i>Ambrosial</i> food.
aroma	A distinctive, typically pleasant smell. <i>The aroma of officialdom.</i>
aromatic	An aromatic compound. <i>An aromatic organic compound.</i>
blending	The act of blending components together thoroughly. <i>The blending of the mythic and the mundane.</i>

bouquet	An expression of approval; a compliment. <i>We will happily publish the bouquets and brickbats.</i>
cloying	Excessively sweet, rich, or sentimental, especially to a disgusting or sickening degree. <i>A romantic rather cloying story.</i>
cosmetic	Serving an aesthetic purpose in beautifying the body. <i>Cosmetic creams.</i>
exasperate	Exasperate or irritate. <i>This futile process exasperates prison officers.</i>
flavorful	Full of flavor.
flowery	(of speech or writing) full of elaborate or literary words and phrases. <i>Her flowery perfume.</i>
fragrant	Pleasant-smelling. <i>She gathered the fragrant blooms.</i>
frankincense	An aromatic gum resin obtained from various Arabian or East African trees; formerly valued for worship and for embalming and fumigation.
incense	The pleasing scent produced when incense is burned. <i>The sharp lingering sweetness of incense.</i>
musk	A strong smelling reddish brown substance which is secreted by the male musk deer for scent marking and is an important ingredient in perfumery.
musky	Having a smell or taste like that of musk.
nectary	A gland (often a protuberance or depression) that secretes nectar.
nosegay	A small bunch of flowers, typically one that is sweet-scented. <i>A nosegay worn at the waist or bodice.</i>
odor	Any property detected by the olfactory system.
odoriferous	Morally offensive. <i>An odoriferous pile of fish.</i>
odorous	Having a natural fragrance. <i>A dark and odorous cave.</i>
perfume	Impregnate with perfume or a sweet smelling substance. <i>Musk based perfumes.</i>
perfumery	Store where perfumes are sold. <i>An oil used in perfumery.</i>
powder	Sprinkle or cover a surface with powder or a powdery substance. <i>She powdered her nose.</i>
redolent	Having a strong pleasant odor- Jean Stafford. <i>Names redolent of history and tradition.</i>

- sandalwood** Close grained fragrant yellowish heartwood of the true sandalwood has insect repelling properties and is used for carving and cabinetwork.
- scent** Catch the scent of get wind of.

- smell** A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent.
