- *A perfume or aftershave.*



## Synonyms of "Fragrance" as a noun (14 Words)

### [aroma](#)

Any property detected by the olfactory system.  
*The **aroma** of officialdom.*

### **balm**

The resinous substance yielded by a balm.  
*The murmur of the water can provide **balm** for troubled spirits.*

### **balminess**

The quality of weather that is deliciously mild and soothing.  
*The day's heat faded into **balminess**.*

### [bouquet](#)

An expression of approval; a compliment.  
*The aperitif has a faint **bouquet** of almonds.*

**eau de toilette** A perfumed liquid lighter than cologne.

### **fragrancy**

Fragrance.

### [nose](#)

A front that resembles a human nose especially the front of an aircraft.  
*He pushed his glasses higher on to the bridge of his **nose**.*

<b>odour</b>	A lingering quality or impression attaching to something. <i>An <b>odour</b> of suspicion.</i>
<b><u>perfume</u></b>	A distinctive odor that is pleasant. <i>I caught a whiff of her fresh lemony <b>perfume</b>.</i>
<b>redolence</b>	A pleasingly sweet olfactory property.
<b><u>scent</u></b>	Any property detected by the olfactory system. <i>The <b>scent</b> of freshly cut hay.</i>
<b>sweet smell</b>	A food rich in sugar.
<b><u>sweetness</u></b>	Used as an affectionate form of address, though often ironically. <i>I ve just got to go <b>sweetness</b>.</i>
<b>toilet water</b>	Misfortune resulting in lost effort or money.

- *The fragrance of fresh-ground coffee.*
- *Men who don't customarily wear fragrance.*



## Associations of "Fragrance" (30 Words)

<b>ambergris</b>	A waxy substance that originates as a secretion in the intestines of the sperm whale, found floating in tropical seas and used in perfume manufacture.
<b>ambrosial</b>	Extremely pleasing to the taste; sweet and fragrant. <i><b>Ambrosial</b> food.</i>
<u><a href="#">aroma</a></u>	A distinctive, typically pleasant smell. <i>The <b>aroma</b> of officialdom.</i>
<u><a href="#">aromatic</a></u>	An aromatic compound. <i>An <b>aromatic</b> organic compound.</i>
<b>blending</b>	The act of blending components together thoroughly. <i>The <b>blending</b> of the mythic and the mundane.</i>

<b>bouquet</b>	An expression of approval; a compliment. <i>We will happily publish the <b>bouquets</b> and brickbats.</i>
<b>cloying</b>	Excessively sweet, rich, or sentimental, especially to a disgusting or sickening degree. <i>A romantic rather <b>cloying</b> story.</i>
<b>cosmetic</b>	Serving an aesthetic purpose in beautifying the body. <i><b>Cosmetic</b> creams.</i>
<b>exasperate</b>	Exasperate or irritate. <i>This futile process <b>exasperates</b> prison officers.</i>
<b>flavorful</b>	Full of flavor.
<b>flowery</b>	(of speech or writing) full of elaborate or literary words and phrases. <i>Her <b>flowery</b> perfume.</i>
<b>fragrant</b>	Pleasant-smelling. <i>She gathered the <b>fragrant</b> blooms.</i>
<b>frankincense</b>	An aromatic gum resin obtained from various Arabian or East African trees; formerly valued for worship and for embalming and fumigation.
<b>incense</b>	The pleasing scent produced when incense is burned. <i>The sharp lingering sweetness of <b>incense</b>.</i>
<b>musk</b>	A strong smelling reddish brown substance which is secreted by the male musk deer for scent marking and is an important ingredient in perfumery.
<b>musky</b>	Having a smell or taste like that of musk.
<b>nectary</b>	A gland (often a protuberance or depression) that secretes nectar.
<b>nosegay</b>	A small bunch of flowers, typically one that is sweet-scented. <i>A <b>nosegay</b> worn at the waist or bodice.</i>
<b>odor</b>	Any property detected by the olfactory system.
<b>odoriferous</b>	Morally offensive. <i>An <b>odoriferous</b> pile of fish.</i>
<b>odorous</b>	Having a natural fragrance. <i>A dark and <b>odorous</b> cave.</i>
<b>perfume</b>	Impregnate with perfume or a sweet smelling substance. <i>Musk based <b>perfumes</b>.</i>
<b>perfumery</b>	Store where perfumes are sold. <i>An oil used in <b>perfumery</b>.</i>
<b>powder</b>	Sprinkle or cover a surface with powder or a powdery substance. <i>She <b>powdered</b> her nose.</i>
<b>redolent</b>	Having a strong pleasant odor- Jean Stafford. <i>Names <b>redolent</b> of history and tradition.</i>

<b>sandalwood</b>	Close grained fragrant yellowish heartwood of the true sandalwood has insect repelling properties and is used for carving and cabinetwork.
<u>scent</u>	Catch the scent of get wind of. <i>The hound followed the <b>scent</b>.</i>
<b>smell</b>	A quality in something that is perceived by the faculty of smell an odour or scent. <i>The soup <b>smells</b> good.</i>
<u>sweet</u>	With sweetening added. <i><b>Sweet</b> dessert wines.</i>
<u>tasty</u>	Involving or good at fighting. <i>A <b>tasty</b> profit margin of 42.</i>
