## Associations of "Framed" (30 Words)

<b>anatomical</b>	Of or relating to the branch of morphology that studies the structure of organisms. <i><b>Anatomical</b> abnormalities.</i>
<b><u>bony</u></b>	Having bones especially many or prominent bones. <i><b>Bony</b> fish.</i>
<b>building</b>	The occupants of a building. <i>There was a three story <b>building</b> on the corner.</i>
<b>concave</b>	Having an outline or surface that curves inwards like the interior of a circle or sphere. <i><b>Concave</b> lenses.</i>
<b>conduit</b>	A channel for conveying water or other fluid. <i>Nearby springs supplied the <b>conduit</b> which ran into the brewery.</i>
<b>cylindrical</b>	Having the form of a cylinder. <i>The cavity is roughly <b>cylindrical</b>.</i>
<b>forelimb</b>	The front limb (or the homologous structure in other animals, such as a flipper or wing).
<b>form</b>	Give shape or form to. <i>His features <b>formed</b> into a smile of pleasure.</i>
<b>framework</b>	A hypothetical description of a complex entity or process. <i>A conservatory in a delicate <b>framework</b> of iron.</i>
<b>jamb</b>	A side post or surface of a doorway, window, or fireplace. <i>He leaned against the door <b>jamb</b>.</i>
<b>lattice</b>	An interlaced structure or pattern resembling a lattice. <i>A <b>lattice</b> fence.</i>
<b>latticed</b>	Decorated with or in the form of a lattice. <i>A <b>latticed</b> screen.</i>
<b>lintel</b>	Horizontal beam used as a finishing piece over a door or window.

<b><u>morph</u></b>	An image that has been morphed. <i>In the video Michael Jackson <b>morphed</b> into a panther.</i>
<b>morphological</b>	Relating to or concerned with the formation of admissible words in a language. <i>The purely <b>morphological</b> fact that with a little dam one could hold back a lot of water.</i>
<b><u>morphology</u></b>	The branch of biology that deals with the form of living organisms, and with relationships between their structures. <i>A generative approach to Italian <b>morphology</b>.</i>
<b>osseous</b>	Consisting of or turned into bone; ossified. <i><b>Osseous</b> tissue.</i>
<b>pane</b>	A panel or section of panels in a wall or door.
<b><u>porch</u></b>	A structure attached to the exterior of a building often forming a covered entrance. <i>Daniel and Lydia sat out on the <b>porch</b> for many hours.</i>
<b>porthole</b>	An opening (in a wall or ship or armored vehicle) for firing through.
<b><u>shape</u></b>	Shape or influence give direction to. <i>She liked the <b>shape</b> of his nose.</i>
<b>sill</b>	A strong horizontal beam forming a base in the frame of a timber-framed building.
<b>skeletal</b>	Relating to or functioning as a skeleton. <i>A nightmare population of gaunt men and <b>skeletal</b> boys.</i>
<b><u>skeleton</u></b>	A sport in which a competitor races down a frozen track on a skeleton sled. <i>The building has a steel <b>skeleton</b>.</i>
<b><u>square</u></b>	Mark out in squares. <i>They felled and <b>squared</b> the timber themselves.</i>
<b>structural</b>	Concerned with systematic structure in a particular field of study. <i><b>Structural</b> effects of folding and faulting of the earth s surface.</i>
<b>structuralism</b>	A method of interpretation and analysis of aspects of human cognition, behaviour, culture, and experience, which focuses on relationships of contrast between elements in a conceptual system.
<b>structure</b>	Give a structure to. <i>His lectures have no <b>structure</b>.</i>
<b>tubular</b>	Made from a tube or tubes. <i>Donatello is totally <b>tubular</b> when he s jamming.</i>

A framework of wood or metal that contains a glass windowpane and is built into a wall or roof to admit light or air.
