## Associations of "Free will" (30 Words)

<b>autonomous</b>	Denoting or performed by a device capable of operating without direct human control. <i>The spread of <b>autonomous</b> robotic weaponry.</i>
<b>complimentary</b>	Expressing a compliment; praising or approving. <i>A <b>complimentary</b> bottle of wine.</i>
<b>discretion</b>	Freedom to act or judge on one’s own. <i>Local authorities should use their <b>discretion</b> in setting the charges.</i>
<b>disengage</b>	Release from something that holds fast, connects, or entangles. <i>They clung together for a moment then she <b>disengaged</b> herself.</i>
<b>dislodge</b>	Knock or force out of position. <i>The hoofs of their horses <b>dislodged</b> loose stones.</i>
<b>emancipate</b>	Free from slavery or servitude. <i>The plaintiffs had not been entirely <b>emancipated</b> from their father’s control.</i>
<b>emancipation</b>	The fact or process of being set free from legal, social, or political restrictions; liberation. <i>The early struggle for <b>emancipation</b> from slavery.</i>
<b>footloose</b>	(of a commercial, industrial, or financial operation) unrestricted in its location or field of operations and able to respond to fluctuations in the market. <i>I am <b>footloose</b> and fancy free I can follow my job wherever it takes me.</i>
<b>freedom</b>	The state of being unrestricted and able to move easily. <i>He was a champion of Irish <b>freedom</b>.</i>
<b>gratis</b>	Given or done for nothing; free. <i>A monthly programme was issued <b>gratis</b>.</i>
<b>illimitable</b>	Without limits in extent or size or quantity. <i>The <b>illimitable</b> human capacity for evil.</i>

<b><u>inexpensive</u></b>	Relatively low in price or charging low prices. <i><b>Inexpensive</b> family restaurants.</i>
<b>leeway</b>	The amount of freedom to move or act that is available. <i>The <b>leeway</b> is only about 2.</i>
<b><u>liberate</u></b>	Steal (something). <i>Twelve months earlier Paris had been <b>liberated</b>.</i>
<b><u>liberation</u></b>	The action of setting someone free from imprisonment, slavery, or oppression; release. <i>The struggle for women s <b>liberation</b>.</i>
<b><u>liberty</u></b>	The personification of liberty as a female figure. <i>How did he know what she was thinking it was a <b>liberty</b>.</i>
<b><u>limitless</u></b>	Without end, limit, or boundary. <i>The <b>limitless</b> reaches of outer space.</i>
<b><u>loosely</u></b>	Without regard to specific details or exceptions. <i>Cover <b>loosely</b> with foil and bake in a preheated oven.</i>
<b>looseness</b>	A lack of strict accuracy; laxity of practice. <i>Misunderstandings can often be traced to a <b>looseness</b> of expression.</i>
<b>manumit</b>	Free from slavery or servitude. <i>Old Angus had never <b>manumitted</b> a single slave.</i>
<b>renewable</b>	A natural resource or source of energy that is not depleted by use, such as water, wind, or solar power. <i>A shift away from fossil fuels to <b>renewable</b> energy.</i>
<b>separatist</b>	Relating to separatists or separatism. <i>Religious <b>separatists</b>.</i>
<b><u>unbounded</u></b>	Seemingly boundless in amount, number, degree, or especially extent. <i><b>Unbounded</b> enthusiasm.</i>
<b><u>unbridled</u></b>	Not restrained or controlled. <i><b>Unbridled</b> lust.</i>
<b>unencumbered</b>	Free of encumbrance. <i>He needed to travel light and <b>unencumbered</b>.</i>
<b>unfettered</b>	Unrestrained or uninhibited. <i><b>Unfettered</b> artistic genius.</i>
<b><u>unofficial</u></b>	Denoting strike action not called or endorsed by the union to which the strikers belong. <i>He participated in an <b>unofficial</b> capacity.</i>
<b><u>unorganized</u></b>	Not represented by or formed into a trade union. <i><b>Unorganized</b> data.</i>

**untie** Cause to become loose.  
*She knelt to **untie** her laces.*
