## The Forms of Fret

|                    |  |
|--------------------|--|
| Infinitive         | <b>to fret</b>                                   |
| Present Tense      | <b>fret / frets</b>                              |
| Past Tense         | <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b>              |
| Present Participle | <b>fretting</b>                                  |
| Past Participle    | <b>fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b> |

## Conjugate Fret

### Fret in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

| <b>Singular</b>        | <b>Plural</b>    |
|------------------------|------------------|
| I <b>fret</b>          | We <b>fret</b>   |
| You <b>fret</b>        | You <b>fret</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>frets</b> | They <b>fret</b> |

### **Fret in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>              | <b>Plural</b>            |
|------------------------------|--------------------------|
| I <b>am fretting</b>         | We <b>are fretting</b>   |
| You <b>are fretting</b>      | You <b>are fretting</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>is fretting</b> | They <b>are fretting</b> |

### **Fret in Present Perfect Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>  | <b>Plural</b>  |
|--|--|
| I <b>have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b>        | We <b>have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b>   |
| You <b>have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b>      | You <b>have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>has fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b> | They <b>have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)</b> |

### **Fret in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>                    | <b>Plural</b>                  |
|------------------------------------|--------------------------------|
| I <b>have been fretting</b>        | We <b>have been fretting</b>   |
| You <b>have been fretting</b>      | You <b>have been fretting</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>has been fretting</b> | They <b>have been fretting</b> |

### **Fret in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

| <b>Singular</b>                               | <b>Plural</b>                            |
|---|--|
| I <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b>         | We <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b>   |
| You <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b>       | You <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b>  |
| He/She/It <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b> | They <b>fretted, fret, fret or frate</b> |

## **Fret in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

### **Singular**

### **Plural**

I **was fretting**                      We **were fretting**  
You **were fretting**                You **were fretting**  
He/She/It **was fretting**        They **were fretting**

## **Fret in Past Perfect Tense**

### **Singular**

### **Plural**

I **had fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**                      We **had fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**  
You **had fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**                      You **had fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**  
He/She/It **had fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**                      They **had fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**

## **Fret in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

### **Plural**

I **had been fretting**                      We **had been fretting**  
You **had been fretting**                      You **had been fretting**  
He/She/It **had been fretting**                      They **had been fretting**

## **Fret in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **will fret**                      We **will fret**  
You **will fret**                      You **will fret**  
He/She/It **will fret**                      They **will fret**

## **Fret in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I **will be fretting**                      We **will be fretting**  
You **will be fretting**                      You **will be fretting**

He/She/It **will be fretting** They **will be fretting**

I **will have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**

We **will have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**

You **will have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**

He/She/It **will have fretted or fretten (usually in compounds)**
