I frustrate

We frustrate

You frustrate

You frustrate

He/She/It frustrates

They frustrate

Frustrate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

I am frustrating

We are frustrating

You are frustrating

You are frustrating

He/She/It is frustrating

They are frustrating

Frustrate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I have frustrated

We have frustrated

You have frustrated

You have frustrated

He/She/It has frustrated

They have frustrated

Frustrate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I have been frustrating

We have been frustrating

You have been frustrating

You have been frustrating

He/She/It has been frustrating

They have been frustrating

Frustrate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I frustrated

We frustrated

You frustrated

You frustrated

He/She/It frustrated

They frustrated

Frustrate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was frustrating We were frustrating
You were frustrating You were frustrating
He/She/It was frustrating They were frustrating

Frustrate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had frustrated We had frustrated
You had frustrated You had frustrated
He/She/It had frustrated They had frustrated

Frustrate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been frustrating We had been frustrating
You had been frustrating You had been frustrating
He/She/It had been frustrating They had been frustrating

Frustrate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will frustrate We will frustrate
You will frustrate You will frustrate
He/She/It will frustrate They will frustrate

Frustrate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be frustrating We will be frustrating
You will be frustrating You will be frustrating
He/She/It will be frustrating They will be frustrating

Frustrate in Future Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I will have frustrated

We will have frustrated

You will have frustrated

You will have frustrated

He/She/It will have frustrated

They will have frustrated

Singular

Plural

I will have been frustrating

We will have been frustrating

You will have been frustrating

You will have been frustrating

He/She/It will have been frustrating

They will have been frustrating
