- accomplish** Put in effect.  
*Once this form has been **accomplished** the applicant needs to secure supporting documents.*
- action** Take action on deal with.  
*The weapon has a smooth **action**.*
- activity** A thermodynamic quantity representing the effective concentration of a particular component in a solution or other system equal to its concentration multiplied by an activity coefficient.  
*His sphere of **activity**.*
- actual** Being or reflecting the essential or genuine character of something-  
G.K.Chesterton.  
*Rocks and trees the **actual** world.*
- actuality** Existing conditions or facts.  
*The building looked as impressive in **actuality** as it did in magazines.*

<b>attain</b>	Reach a destination, either real or abstract. <i>Clarify your objectives and ways of <b>attaining</b> them.</i>
<b>bulge</b>	Cause to bulge or swell outwards. <i>His stomach <b>bulged</b> after the huge meal.</i>
<b>content</b>	Make content. <i>Not <b>content</b> with being a hugely successful pop star he now intends to venture into movies.</i>
<b>covenant</b>	Enter into a covenant. <i>There was a <b>covenant</b> between them that her name was never to be mentioned.</i>
<b>do</b>	Get something done. <i>The special formula continues to beautify your tan when the day is <b>done</b>.</i>
<b>fill</b>	Fill satisfy or meet a want or need or condition or restriction. <i>We have eaten our <b>fill</b>.</i>
<b>fulfill</b>	Fill or meet a want or need.
<b>fulfillment</b>	A feeling of satisfaction at having achieved your desires.
<b>garnishment</b>	A court order directing that money or property of a third party (usually wages paid by an employer) be seized to satisfy a debt owed by a debtor to a plaintiff creditor.
<b>gratification</b>	State of being gratified or satisfied. <i>Dull repetitious work gives no <b>gratification</b>.</i>
<b>gratify</b>	Give (someone) pleasure or satisfaction. <i>Not all the sexual impulses can be gratified.</i>
<b>indulge</b>	Treat with excessive indulgence. <i>We <b>indulged</b> in a cream tea.</i>
<b>indulging</b>	The act of indulging or gratifying a desire.
<b>meet</b>	Fill satisfy or meet a want or need or condition or restriction. <i>I ll probably see you at the <b>meeting</b>.</i>
<b>perform</b>	Perform a function. <i>The play has already been <b>performed</b> in Britain.</i>
<b>promise</b>	Promise to undertake or give. <i>I <b>promise</b> you my best effort.</i>
<b>reliably</b>	In a consistently good or accurate way. <i>Few of these paintings can be <b>reliably</b> dated.</i>
<b>replete</b>	Deeply filled or permeated. <i>Sensational popular fiction <b>replete</b> with adultery and sudden death.</i>

<b>restock</b>	Replenish (a store) with fresh stock or supplies. <i>Work began at once to <b>restock</b> the fishery.</i>
<b>sate</b>	Fill to satisfaction. <i><b>Sate</b> your appetite at the resort s restaurant.</i>
<b>satisfaction</b>	The payment of a debt or fulfillment of an obligation. <i>Managing directors seeking greater job <b>satisfaction</b>.</i>
<b>satisfy</b>	Fill satisfy or meet a want or need or condtion ro restriction. <i>The whole team is working flat out to <b>satisfy</b> demand.</i>
<b>sooth</b>	Truth. <i>In <b>sooth</b>.</i>
<b>supplement</b>	A supplementary component that improves capability. <i><b>Supplement</b> your diet.</i>
<b><u>vouch</u></b>	Summon a vouchee into court to warrant or defend a title. <i>I <b>vouch</b> for the quality of my products.</i>
