abundant	Having plenty of. An abundant supply of water.
abundantly	Extremely. They were abundantly supplied with food.
adequacy	The quality of being sufficient for the end in view. The adequacy of testing procedures.
adequate	About average; acceptable. <i>She was adequate to the job.</i>
adequately	To a satisfactory or acceptable extent. The job requirements were not adequately explained.
<u>affluent</u>	An affluent person a person who is financially well off. An affluent banker.
ample	Fairly large in size. There is ample time for discussion.
amply	Enough or more than enough; plentifully. They were fully or amply fed.
appropriately	In a manner that is suitable or proper in the circumstances. Walls of raw concrete form a neutral yet appropriately rugged backdrop for the various objects.
bountiful	Given or giving freely. This bountiful God has thought of everything.
bountifulness	The property of copious abundance.
<u>bounty</u>	A sum paid for killing or capturing a person or animal. For millennia the people along the Nile have depended entirely on its bounty .
<u>copious</u>	Profuse in speech or ideas. She took copious notes.



copiously	In an expansive or wide-ranging way. His book is copiously annotated with references to the current debates.
exceeding	Extremely exceedingly. A night of exceeding darkness.
<u>fairly</u>	To a moderately high degree. <i>He could not fairly be accused of wasting police time.</i>
full	Make a garment fuller by pleating or gathering. A sky full of stars.
fully	No less or fewer than (used to emphasize an amount. I fully understand the fears of the workers.
lot	Divide into lots as of land for example. <i>Has a happy lot</i> .
moderately	To a moderately sufficient extent or degree. Both hotels are moderately priced.
passable	(of a route or road) clear of obstacles and able to be travelled on. <i>The road is passable</i> .
plentiful	Existing in or yielding great quantities; abundant. Rhinoceroses were once plentiful here.
plentitude	A full supply.
profusion	The property of being extremely abundant. The profusion of detail.
replete	Fill to satisfaction. I went out into the sun drenched streets again replete and relaxed.
<u>suffice</u>	Be enough or adequate. A B grade doesn t suffice to get me into medical school.
sufficiency	Self sufficiency or independence of character especially of an arrogant or imperious sort. There is more than a sufficiency of lawyers in this country.
<u>sufficient</u>	Of a quantity that can fulfill a need or requirement but without being abundant. <i>Sufficient</i> food.
suitability	The quality of having the properties that are right for a specific purpose. <i>Her superiors had doubts about her suitability for the job.</i>
validation	Recognition or affirmation that a person or their feelings or opinions are valid or worthwhile. New courses subject to validation include an MSc in Urban Forestry.
