### Definitions of "Furnish" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “furnish” as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Be a source of; provide.*
- *Provide or equip with furniture.*
- *Supply someone with (something); give (something) to someone.*
- *Provide (a house or room) with furniture and fittings.*
- *Give something useful or necessary to.*



## Synonyms of "Furnish" as a verb (21 Words)

<b>appoint</b>	Decide the disposition of (property of which one is not the owner) under powers granted by the owner. <i>Such laws are <b>appointed</b> by God.</i>
<b><u>embellish</u></b>	Add details to. <i>Followers often <b>embellish</b> stories about their heroes.</i>
<b>enhance</b>	Make better or more attractive. <i>This sauce will <b>enhance</b> the flavor of the meat.</i>
<b><u>equip</u></b>	Provide with (something) usually for a specific purpose. <i>She was never <b>equipped</b> to be a dancer.</i>
<b>fit out</b>	Satisfy a condition or restriction.
<b>fix up</b>	Influence an event or its outcome by illegal means.
<b>furnish with</b>	Provide or equip with furniture.
<b>gift with</b>	Give qualities or abilities to.

<b>grant</b>	Transfer by deed. <i>Funds are <b>granted</b> to qualified researchers.</i>
<b>issue</b>	Make out and issue. <i>Water <b>issued</b> from the hole in the wall.</i>
<b>outfit</b>	Provide with (something) usually for a specific purpose. <i>Planes <b>outfitted</b> with sophisticated electronic gear.</i>
<b>present</b>	Represent abstractly for example in a painting drawing or sculpture. <i>We <b>presented</b> the arguments to him.</i>
<b>present with</b>	Hand over formally.
<b>provide</b>	Make a possibility or provide opportunity for permit to be attainable or cause to remain. <i>The Bill <b>provides</b> for the setting of guaranteed service standards.</i>
<b>provide with</b>	Mount or put up.
<b>provide with furniture</b>	Determine (what is to happen in certain contingencies), especially by including a proviso condition or stipulation.
<b>provision</b>	Supply with provisions. <i>The <b>provisioning</b> of US ships.</i>
<b>render</b>	Give up surrender. <i>They had to <b>render</b> the estate.</i>
<b>rig out</b>	Equip with sails or masts.
<b>supply</b>	State or say further. <i>The two reservoirs <b>supply</b> about 1 of the city s needs.</i>
<b>supply with</b>	Give what is desired or needed, especially support, food or sustenance.



## Usage Examples of "Furnish" as a verb

- *She was able to furnish me with details of the incident.*
- *We furnished the house in the Biedermeyer style.*
- *The proprietor has furnished the bedrooms in a variety of styles.*
- *Fish furnish an important source of protein.*

- adduce** Advance evidence for.  
*A number of factors are **adduced** to explain the situation.*
- arranged** Deliberately arranged for effect.  
*An **arranged** marriage.*
- cater** Give what is desired or needed, especially support, food or sustenance.  
*My mother helped to **cater** for the party.*
- configure** Arrange or order (a computer system or an element of it) so as to fit it for a designated task.  
*The memory can be **configured** as a virtual drive.*
- equip** Provide with (something) usually for a specific purpose.  
*They **equipped** themselves for the campaign.*
- establish** Build or establish something abstract.  
*The scheme was **established** in 1975.*

<b>fixing</b>	The process of deciding or planning something. <i>Bikes can be mounted on roof bars with special <b>fixings</b>.</i>
<b><u>install</u></b>	Set up for use. <i>He was <b>installed</b> as Prime Minister in 1966.</i>
<b>offering</b>	The verbal act of offering. <i><b>Offerings</b> during Lent will always be gratefully received.</i>
<b>ordered</b>	Marked by an orderly, logical, and aesthetically consistent relation of parts. <i>An <b>ordered</b> sequence.</i>
<b><u>outfit</u></b>	A group of people undertaking a particular activity together, especially a group of musicians, a team, or a business concern. <i>Her wedding <b>outfit</b>.</i>
<b>preparation</b>	The cognitive process of thinking about what you will do in the event of something happening. <i>There are several effective <b>preparations</b> you can buy over the counter.</i>
<b>prepared</b>	Equipped or prepared with necessary intellectual resources. <i><b>Prepared</b> to take risks.</i>
<b><u>procurement</u></b>	The action or occupation of acquiring military equipment and supplies. <i>Defence <b>procurement</b>.</i>
<b>provide</b>	Make a possibility or provide opportunity for permit to be attainable or cause to remain. <i>He <b>provides</b> for his large family by working three jobs.</i>
<b>provider</b>	Someone whose business is to supply a particular service or commodity. <i>A leading <b>provider</b> of personal financial services.</i>
<b>provision</b>	Supply with provisions. <i>Changing levels of transport <b>provision</b>.</i>
<b>purvey</b>	Provide or supply (food, drink, or other goods) as one's business. <i>Shops <b>purveying</b> cooked food.</i>
<b>ready</b>	Make ready or suitable or equip in advance for a particular purpose or for some use event etc. <i>I expect you re <b>ready</b> for a drink.</i>
<b>refuel</b>	(of a vehicle) be supplied with more fuel. <i>The chopper went to <b>refuel</b>.</i>
<b>render</b>	To surrender someone or something to another. <i>He is forced to <b>render</b> images by intermixing pixels of a few basic colours.</i>
<b><u>replenish</u></b>	Fill (something) up again. <i>All creatures need sleep to <b>replenish</b> their energies.</i>

- replenishment** Restoration of a stock or supply to a former level or condition.  
*A target for **replenishment** of depleted fish stocks.*
- restock** Replenish (a store) with fresh stock or supplies.  
*He **restocked** his land with pheasants.*
- rig** Provide a sailing boat with sails and rigging.  
***Rig** an election.*
- sacrifice** Make a sacrifice of in religious rituals.  
*In that event East West would **sacrifice** in six spades.*
- setup** Equipment designed to serve a specific function.  
*It takes time to learn the **setup** around here.*
- supplement** A supplementary component that improves capability.  
*The handout is a **supplement** to the official manual.*
- supplier** A person or organization that provides something needed such as a product or service.  
*Every major energy **supplier** upped their prices.*
- supply** The activity of supplying or providing something.  
*When she died no one could **supply** her place.*
