- *The movable articles that are used to make a room or building suitable for living or working in, such as tables, chairs, or desks.*
- *The mountings of a rifle.*
- *Pieces of wood or metal placed round or between metal type to make blank spaces and fasten the type in the chase.*

amenities

Things that make you comfortable and at ease.

appliances

Durable goods for home or office use.

appointments

Furnishings and equipment (especially for a ship or hotel).
The appointment had to be approved by the whole committee.

article of furniture

One of a class of artifacts.

chattels

Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc).

effects

Property of a personal character that is portable but not used in business.
*I watched over their **effects** until they returned.*

equipment

The process of supplying someone or something with necessary equipment.
*Suppliers of office **equipment**.*

| fitments | Any of the items furnishing or equipping a room (especially built-in furniture). <i>She liked the kitchen fitments.</i> |
| fittings | Putting clothes on to see whether they fit. |
| fixtures | An object firmly fixed in place (especially in a household). <i>A bum who is a Central Park fixture.</i> |
| house fittings | The members of a religious community living together. |
| movables | Personal as opposed to real property; any tangible movable property (furniture or domestic animals or a car etc). |
| <u>paraphernalia</u> | Miscellaneous articles, especially the equipment needed for a particular activity. <i>The rituals and paraphernalia of government.</i> |
| piece of furniture | A share of something. |
| units | An individual or group or structure or other entity regarded as a structural or functional constituent of a whole. <i>The reduced the number of units and installations.</i> |

- *There was only one piece of furniture in the room.*
- *The gun is fitted with wooden furniture.*
- *They had too much furniture for the small apartment.*
- *The more sophisticated Mac furniture—number wheels, colour pickers, and so on.*

| console | Comfort (someone) at a time of grief or disappointment. <i>You can console yourself with the thought that you did your best.</i> |
| cupboard | A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom cupboard.</i> |
| curtain | Conceal or screen with a curtain. <i>It looked like curtains for me.</i> |
| cushion | The layer of air supporting a hovercraft or similar vehicle. <i>To cushion the blow wages and pensions were increased.</i> |
| desk | A specified section of a newspaper or broadcasting organization. <i>The reception desk.</i> |
| drawer | A boxlike container in a piece of furniture; made so as to slide in and out. <i>The banker would have rights as holder to pursue the drawer.</i> |
| filing | Preservation and methodical arrangement as of documents and papers etc. <i>I have some filing to do.</i> |
| fridge | A refrigerator in which the coolant is pumped around by an electric motor. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the fridge.</i> |
| furnishing | The act of decorating a house or room. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i> |
| interior | The inland part of a country or region. <i>Interior scenes.</i> |
| kitchen | A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>A fully fitted kitchen at a bargain price.</i> |
| mattress | A fabric case filled with soft, firm, or springy material, used for sleeping on. |
| pillow | Rest on or as if on a pillow. <i>Her transparent cheek all pale and warm pillow d his deathlike forehead.</i> |
| rack | Go at a rack. <i>A spice rack.</i> |
| recliner | A chair with a reclining back, especially one with an integral footrest. |
| reshuffle | A redistribution of something. <i>Youngman is requesting that Garcia reshuffle the cards.</i> |
| seat | Put a seat on a chair. <i>The mother seated the toddler on the high chair.</i> |

- sleeper** A sleeping pill.
*The winner was a true **sleeper** no one expected him to get it.*
- sofa** A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people.
***Sofa** cushions.*
- stool** Grow shoots in the form of stools or tillers.
*Fibre in the child s diet will soften the **stools**.*
- table** The dummy hand which is exposed on the table.
*More than 200 amendments to the bill have already been **tabled**.*
- wardrobe** A person's entire collection of clothes.
*Her **wardrobe** is extensive.*
