addition	The process of combining matrices, vectors, or other quantities under specific rules to obtain their sum or resultant. <i>He was a new addition to the staff.</i>
advance	Pay in advance. <i>She rejected his advances.</i>
also	In addition; too. <i>Dyslexia also known as word blindness.</i>
aphelion	The point in the orbit of a planet, asteroid, or comet at which it is furthest from the sun. <i>Mars is at aphelion.</i>
approximative	Not quite exact or correct. <i>A crudely approximative outline.</i>
backlash	Recoil arising between parts of a mechanism. <i>There was a backlash of intolerance.</i>
bounce	Hit something so that it bounces. <i>The rubber ball bounced.</i>
bumpy	Covered with or full of bumps. <i>Investors could be in for a bumpy ride.</i>
closeness	A feeling of being intimate and belonging together. <i>The translator's closeness to the original time period.</i>
distance	The distance from the winning post which a horse must have reached when the winner finishes in order to qualify for a subsequent heat. <i>At a distance of ten years he had forgotten many of the details.</i>
distant	Remote in manner. <i>Distant events.</i>
endlessly	With unflagging resolve. <i>An endlessly fascinating subject.</i>

<u>extensively</u>	To a large or detailed degree. <i>The house was extensively damaged by the fire.</i>
<u>far</u>	To a considerable degree; very much. <i>The horse on the right is the far horse.</i>
farther	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i>Farther from the truth.</i>
forth	From a particular thing or place or position forth is obsolete. <i>From that time forth.</i>
<u>furthermore</u>	In addition; besides (used to introduce a fresh consideration in an argument). <i>Computer chess games are getting cheaper all the time furthermore their quality is improving.</i>
<u>increasingly</u>	Advancing in amount or intensity. <i>An increasingly difficult situation.</i>
infinitely	Without bounds. <i>Infinitely divisible magnitudes.</i>
<u>leap</u>	Cause to jump or leap. <i>Amid the notes a couple of items leap out.</i>
<u>long</u>	Of elongated shape. <i>The Cambridge side played the ball long.</i>
mile	A footrace extending one mile. <i>This is my favourite film by a mile.</i>
more	Moreover. <i>We have no more bananas.</i>
<u>moreover</u>	As a further matter; besides. <i>The cellar was dark moreover mice nested there.</i>
outlying	Relatively far from a center or middle. <i>Outlying settlements.</i>
<u>outside</u>	Functioning outside the boundaries or precincts of an organized unit. <i>I was able to face the outside world again.</i>
progressively	Steadily; in stages. <i>A circle of progressively minded reformers.</i>
<u>rebound</u>	The act of securing possession of the rebounding basketball after a missed shot. <i>He had twenty two points and six rebounds and missed only three shots.</i>

resurface

Cover with a new surface.

*The missing man suddenly **resurfaced** in New York.*

spring

Move rapidly or suddenly from a constrained position by or as if by the action of a spring.

*The **spring** was broken.*
