## Associations of "Furthering" (30 Words)

<b>addition</b>	The process of combining matrices, vectors, or other quantities under specific rules to obtain their sum or resultant. <i>He was a new <b>addition</b> to the staff.</i>
<b>advance</b>	Pay in advance. <i>She rejected his <b>advances</b>.</i>
<b>also</b>	In addition; too. <i>Dyslexia <b>also</b> known as word blindness.</i>
<b>aphelion</b>	The point in the orbit of a planet, asteroid, or comet at which it is furthest from the sun. <i>Mars is at <b>aphelion</b>.</i>
<b>approximative</b>	Not quite exact or correct. <i>A crudely <b>approximative</b> outline.</i>
<a href="#">backlash</a>	Recoil arising between parts of a mechanism. <i>There was a <b>backlash</b> of intolerance.</i>
<b>bounce</b>	Hit something so that it bounces. <i>The rubber ball <b>bounced</b>.</i>
<a href="#">bumpy</a>	Covered with or full of bumps. <i>Investors could be in for a <b>bumpy</b> ride.</i>
<a href="#">closeness</a>	A feeling of being intimate and belonging together. <i>The translator's <b>closeness</b> to the original time period.</i>
<a href="#">distance</a>	The distance from the winning post which a horse must have reached when the winner finishes in order to qualify for a subsequent heat. <i>At a <b>distance</b> of ten years he had forgotten many of the details.</i>
<a href="#">distant</a>	Remote in manner. <i><b>Distant</b> events.</i>
<a href="#">endlessly</a>	With unflagging resolve. <i>An <b>endlessly</b> fascinating subject.</i>

<b><u>extensively</u></b>	To a large or detailed degree. <i>The house was <b>extensively</b> damaged by the fire.</i>
<b><u>far</u></b>	To a considerable degree; very much. <i>The horse on the right is the <b>far</b> horse.</i>
<b>farther</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i><b>Farther</b> from the truth.</i>
<b>forth</b>	From a particular thing or place or position forth is obsolete. <i>From that time <b>forth</b>.</i>
<b><u>furthermore</u></b>	In addition; besides (used to introduce a fresh consideration in an argument). <i>Computer chess games are getting cheaper all the time <b>furthermore</b> their quality is improving.</i>
<b><u>increasingly</u></b>	Advancing in amount or intensity. <i>An <b>increasingly</b> difficult situation.</i>
<b>infinitely</b>	Without bounds. <i><b>Infinitely</b> divisible magnitudes.</i>
<b><u>leap</u></b>	Cause to jump or leap. <i>Amid the notes a couple of items <b>leap</b> out.</i>
<b><u>long</u></b>	Of elongated shape. <i>The Cambridge side played the ball <b>long</b>.</i>
<b>mile</b>	A footrace extending one mile. <i>This is my favourite film by a <b>mile</b>.</i>
<b>more</b>	Moreover. <i>We have no <b>more</b> bananas.</i>
<b><u>moreover</u></b>	As a further matter; besides. <i>The cellar was dark <b>moreover</b> mice nested there.</i>
<b>outlying</b>	Relatively far from a center or middle. <i><b>Outlying</b> settlements.</i>
<b><u>outside</u></b>	Functioning outside the boundaries or precincts of an organized unit. <i>I was able to face the <b>outside</b> world again.</i>
<b>progressively</b>	Steadily; in stages. <i>A circle of <b>progressively</b> minded reformers.</i>
<b><u>rebound</u></b>	The act of securing possession of the rebounding basketball after a missed shot. <i>He had twenty two points and six <b>rebounds</b> and missed only three shots.</i>

**resurface**

Cover with a new surface.

*The missing man suddenly **resurfaced** in New York.*

**spring**

Move rapidly or suddenly from a constrained position by or as if by the action of a spring.

*The **spring** was broken.*
