unavailing Achieving little or nothing; ineffective.

Their efforts were unavailing.

vain

Unproductive of success.

A **vain** attempt to tidy up the room.

stillborn (of newborn infant) showing no signs of life at birth; not liveborn.

The proposed wealth tax was **stillborn**.

trivia Something of small importance.

We fill our days with meaningless **trivia**.

(usually followed by 'to') not having the necessary means or skill or

Achieving little or nothing; ineffective. unavailing

Not fruitful; not conducive to abundant production. unfruitful
