- avant-garde** Radically new or original.
(of a new invention or product) based on untested ideas or techniques and not yet established or finalized.
- experimental** *An **experimental** drug.*
- fresh** Not yet used or soiled.
*One truck driver decided to get **fresh** with me.*
- futurist** Relating to a vision of the future.
*The grim urban setting of the novel would have been a **futurist** nightmare.*
- ingenious** Showing inventiveness and skill.
*His theory while **ingenious** is most assuredly incorrect.*
- innovational** Being or producing something like nothing done or experienced or created before.
*A mind so **innovational** so original.*

<u>inventive</u>	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>Inventive</i> ceramics.
new	Beginning anew and in a transformed way. <i>The new men were eager to fight.</i>
<u>novel</u>	Original and of a kind not seen before. <i>The computer produced a completely novel proof of a well known theorem.</i>
<u>original</u>	Present or existing from the beginning; first or earliest. <i>Restored the house to its original condition.</i>
unconventional	Not conforming to legality, moral law, or social convention. <i>His unconventional approach to life.</i>
<u>unfamiliar</u>	Not known or well known. <i>His voice was unfamiliar to her.</i>
unorthodox	Independent in behavior or thought. <i>An unorthodox lifestyle.</i>
unprecedented	Never done or known before. <i>The government took the unprecedented step of releasing confidential correspondence.</i>
unusual	Not commonly encountered. <i>A man of unusual ability.</i>
