Infinitive	<b>to gack</b>
Present Tense	<b>gack / gacks</b>
Past Tense	<b>gacked</b>
Present Participle	<b>gacking</b>
Past Participle	<b>gacked</b>

## **Conjugate Gack**

### **Gack in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>gack</b>	We <b>gack</b>
You <b>gack</b>	You <b>gack</b>
He/She/It <b>gacks</b>	They <b>gack</b>

## **Gack in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am gacking</b>	We <b>are gacking</b>
You <b>are gacking</b>	You <b>are gacking</b>
He/She/It <b>is gacking</b>	They <b>are gacking</b>

## **Gack in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have gacked</b>	We <b>have gacked</b>
You <b>have gacked</b>	You <b>have gacked</b>
He/She/It <b>has gacked</b>	They <b>have gacked</b>

## **Gack in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been gacking</b>	We <b>have been gacking</b>
You <b>have been gacking</b>	You <b>have been gacking</b>
He/She/It <b>has been gacking</b>	They <b>have been gacking</b>

I <b>gacked</b>	We <b>gacked</b>
You <b>gacked</b>	You <b>gacked</b>

<b>I was gacking</b>	<b>We were gacking</b>
<b>You were gacking</b>	<b>You were gacking</b>
<b>He/She/It was gacking</b>	<b>They were gacking</b>

**Gack in Past Perfect Tense**

<b>I had gacked</b>	<b>We had gacked</b>
<b>You had gacked</b>	<b>You had gacked</b>
<b>He/She/It had gacked</b>	<b>They had gacked</b>

**Gack in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been gacking</b>	<b>We had been gacking</b>
<b>You had been gacking</b>	<b>You had been gacking</b>
<b>He/She/It had been gacking</b>	<b>They had been gacking</b>

**Gack in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>I will gack</b>	<b>We will gack</b>
<b>You will gack</b>	<b>You will gack</b>
<b>He/She/It will gack</b>	<b>They will gack</b>

**Gack in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>I will be gacking</b>	<b>We will be gacking</b>
<b>You will be gacking</b>	<b>You will be gacking</b>
<b>He/She/It will be gacking</b>	<b>They will be gacking</b>

**I will have gacked**

**We will have gacked**

**You will have gacked**

**You will have gacked**

**He/She/It will have gacked**

**They will have gacked**

**Gack in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been gacking**

**We will have been gacking**

**You will have been gacking**

**You will have been gacking**

**He/She/It will have been gacking**

**They will have been gacking**
