# **Conjugate Gain**

## Gain in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>gain</b>	We <b>gain</b>
You <b>gain</b>	You <b>gain</b>
He/She/It gains	They <b>gain</b>

## **Gain in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>am gaining</b>	We <b>are gaining</b>
You <b>are gaining</b>	You <b>are gaining</b>
He/She/It is gaining	They <b>are gaining</b>

#### **Gain in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have gained	We have gained
You have gained	You <b>have gained</b>
He/She/It has gained	They have gained

#### **Gain in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been gaining	We have been gaining
You <b>have been gaining</b>	You <b>have been gaining</b>
He/She/It has been gaining	They have been gaining

## Gain in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I gained	We <b>gained</b>
You <b>gained</b>	You <b>gained</b>
He/She/It gained	They <b>gained</b>

## **Gain in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was gaining	We <b>were gaining</b>
You <b>were gaining</b>	You were gaining
He/She/It was gaining	They were gaining

#### **Gain in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had gained	We <b>had gained</b>
You <b>had gained</b>	You <b>had gained</b>
He/She/It had gained	They had gained

### **Gain in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been gaining	We had been gaining
You <b>had been gaining</b>	You had been gaining
He/She/It had been gaining	They had been gaining

## Gain in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will gain</b>	We <b>will gain</b>
You <b>will gain</b>	You <b>will gain</b>
He/She/It will gain	They <b>will gain</b>

## Gain in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be gaining	We <b>will be gaining</b>
You <b>will be gaining</b>	You <b>will be gaining</b>
He/She/It will be gaining	They will be gaining

I will have been gaining	We <b>will have been gaining</b>
